 SSH's are actuals, or figures calculated at the end of the semester. Thus all students receiving WD grades have been removed from the count.  
 Summer sessions are combined and are as of the first week in September.  
 The New Jersey sector for State Colleges and Universities recently established a uniform methodology to calculate FTE's or full-time Equivalencies at the undergraduate level.  
 The FTE's for undergraduates, in the tables above, are now based on 15 credits instead of 16 credits used in prior reports. FTE are calculated by dividing undergraduate SSHs by 15 credits and graduate SSHs by 12 credits per semester.
