* Starting in fall '02, newly entering full-time undergraduate students are charged a flat rate tuition charge per semester; fees are additional. Full-time is defined as 12 or more credits. New in-state undergraduates with less than 12 credits are charged \$233.05 per credit, including fees, per semester. Continuing undergraduates may choose the new flat rate plan or continue with a \$218.06 per credit, including fees, charge.

** Starting in fall '02, newly entering full-time out-of-state undergraduate students are charged a flat rate charge per semester, fees are additional. Full-time is defined as 12 or more credits. New out-of-state undergraduates with less than 12 credits are charged \$355.26 per credit, including fees, per semester. Continuing undergraduates may choose the new flat rate plan or continue with a \$334.78 per credit, including fees, charge.

*** In fall 1999, graduate tuition reflects the newly added Ed.D and M.F.A. programs. A new M.B.A. tuition also began in fall 1999.

Annual tuition and fees for full-time, in-state new undergraduates in Academic Year 2004/05 is \$7,026 (based on 15 credits per semester).

**Annual room and board (based on double occupancy and a 14 meal plan) in Academic Year 2004/2005 is \$7,832
Twenty-seven percent of the undergraduate student body lives on-campus.**
