[1] Faculty headcounts are made following IPEDS guidelines, and include individuals on leave with pay (e.g. on sabbatical) while excluding individuals on unpaid leave.

All headcounts reflect currently filled positions, and exclude vacant, or unfilled, lines (i.e., this is not a departmental line count).

[2] Abbreviations used for full-time faculty are: 1) TE=tenured; 2) TT=tenure-track; and 3) NTT=not tenure-track.

[3] Includes only those part-time faculty who occupy salaried positions (i.e., non-salaried Adjuncts and Visiting Specialists are excluded).

[4] Includes non-salaried Adjuncts and Visiting Specialists (ADJ/VS). While Adjuncts and Visiting Specialists may teach in more than one Department, they are counted in only one (i.e., the ADJ/VS headcount is unduplicated).

[5] The FTE (full-time equivalent) count equals the total headcount of full-time faculty (including sabbaticals), plus 1/3 the total headcount of part-time faculty (both salaried and adjunct/visiting specialist)(both salaried and adjunct/visiting specialist).

[6] Percent tenured is calculated by dividing the number of full-time tenured faculty (TE) by the total headcount of full-time faculty, including those on sabbatical.
