[1] Instructional Staff headcounts are made following IPEDS guidelines, and include individuals on leave with pay (e.g. on sabbatical) while excluding individuals on unpaid leave. All headcounts reflect currently filled positions, and exclude vacant, or unfilled, lines (i.e., this is not a departmental line count). Primary department only (for joint appointments).

[2] Abbreviations used for full-time instructional staff are: 1) TE=tenured; 2) TT=tenure-track; 3) NTT=not tenure-track; and 4) SAB=on sabbatical. Instructional staff on sabbatical are subtracted from the TE column so that the sum of all four full-time categories represents an unduplicated headcount of full-time instructional staff.

[3] Includes part-time, salaried instructional staff. Adjuncts, Visiting Specialists, and other, unsalaried part-time instructors are excluded.

[4] The FTE (full-time equivalent) count equals the total headcount of full-time instructional staff (including sabbaticals), plus 1/3 the total headcount of part-time instructional staff (both salaried and adjunct/visiting specialist).

[5] Percent tenured is calculated by dividing the headcount of tenured, full-time instructional staff (TE) by the combined headcount of tenured and tenure-track (TE+TT) full-time instructional staff, including those on sabbatical. Full-time instructional staff who are not tenure-track (NTT) are excluded from the denominator in this calculation.

[6] Includes non-salaried Adjuncts and Visiting Specialists (ADJ/VS). While Adjuncts and Visiting Specialists may teach in more than one Department, they are counted in only one (i.e., the ADJ/VS headcount is unduplicated). Also includes instructional staff on transition to retirement.
