Our records show that your institution returned a total of 504 completed surveys available for reporting.¹ This report includes the results for all 504 respondents, with comparison results from all respondents at institutions of similar type.

Because the responses of students who have attended college for three years or less are so different than those who have attended four or more years, HERI also produces a separate report for each of these two groups provided that the report contains at least 15 respondents.² Using the algorithm shown below, HERI has determined that:

- 461 indicated they attended college for four or more years, and
- 43 indicated they attended college for three or fewer years.

Accordingly, we are also including in this package reports for both groups.

The results for your institution and those for the comparison groups are automatically broken out by gender. Please note, however, results for one or both genders will be suppressed if they are based on less than 15 respondents. The total results are always presented.

ALGORITHM FOR DETERMINING RESPONDENT TYPE

Question #1 ("What year did you first enter: your 1st college/this college?") is examined. Respondents indicating they entered his/her first college before 2002 are considered to have attended college "four or more years". Respondents who indicated entering their first college in 2002 or later are considered to have attended college "three or fewer years".

For those respondents who did not indicate when the entered their first college, the response for "entering this college" is used instead.

For those respondents who skipped question #1 entirely, Question #4A ("Please indicate the highest degree you will have earned as of June 2005") is examined. Respondents indicating they will have earned at least a Bachelor's-level degree are considered to have attended college "four or more years". Those who responded "None", "Vocational Certificate" or "Associate" are considered to have attended college "three or fewer years".
