In '01 there were 12 applications, 7 completed applications, 6 doctoral students were accepted, and 3 enrolled. In '02 there were 15 applications, 14 completed applications, 6 doctoral students were accepted, and 5 enrolled. In '03 there were 14 applications and 9 students were accepted and enrolled. In '04 there were 33 applications, 29 completed applications, 23 doctoral students were accepted and 20 enrolled.
