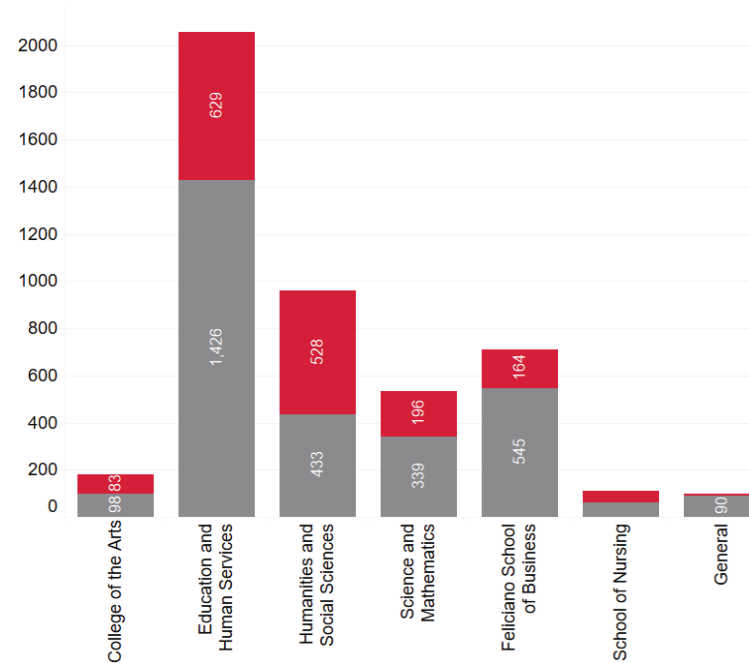

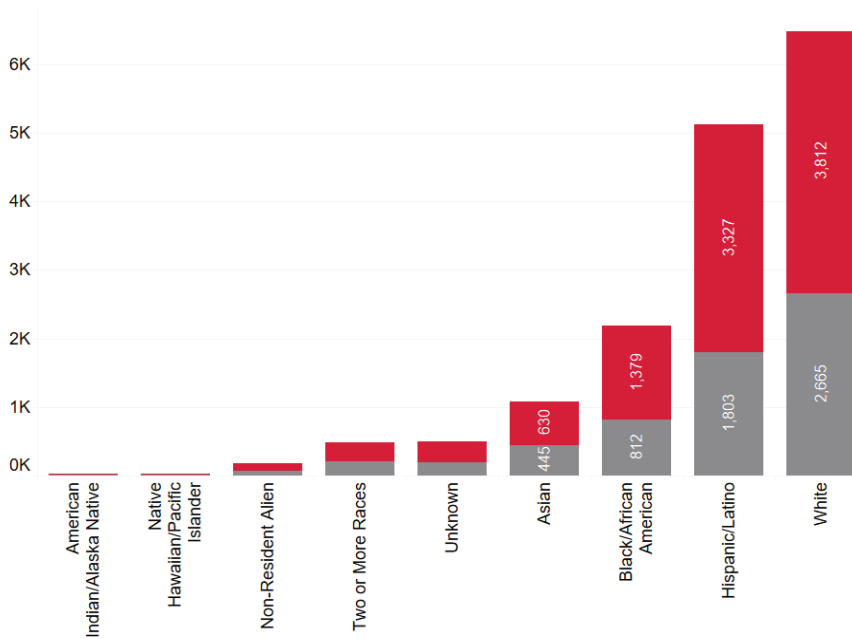

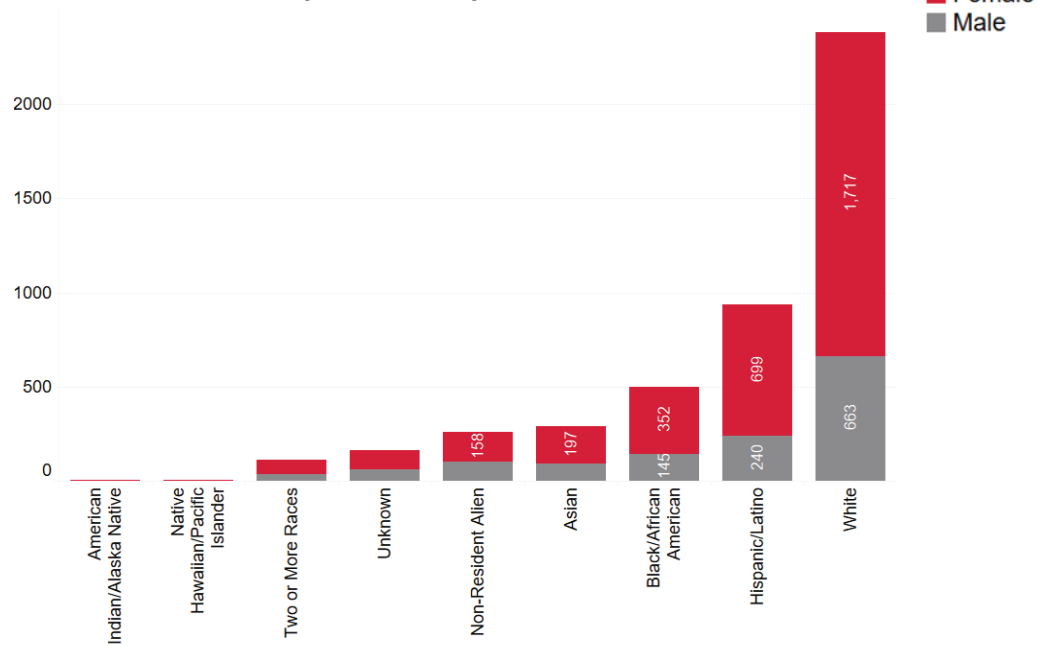

Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Gender





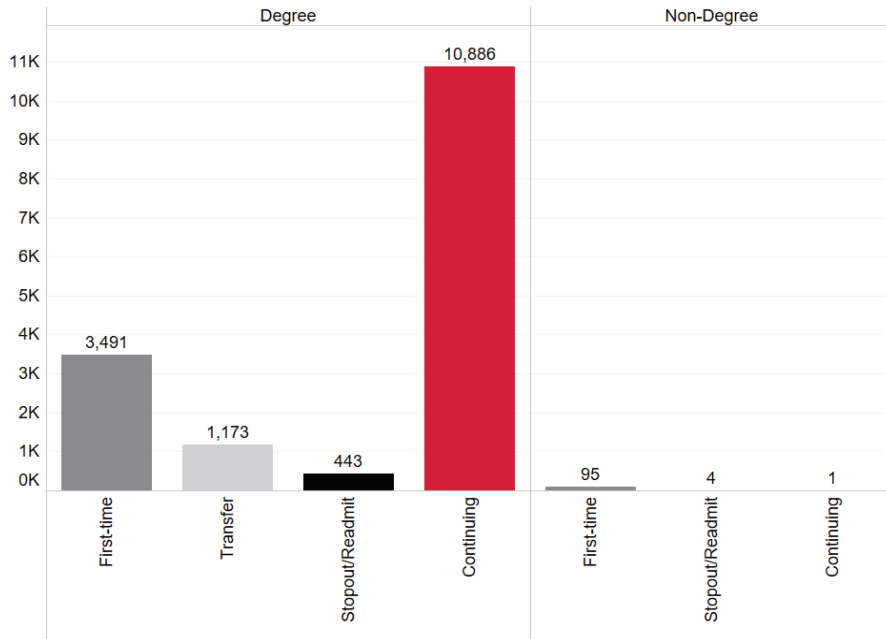

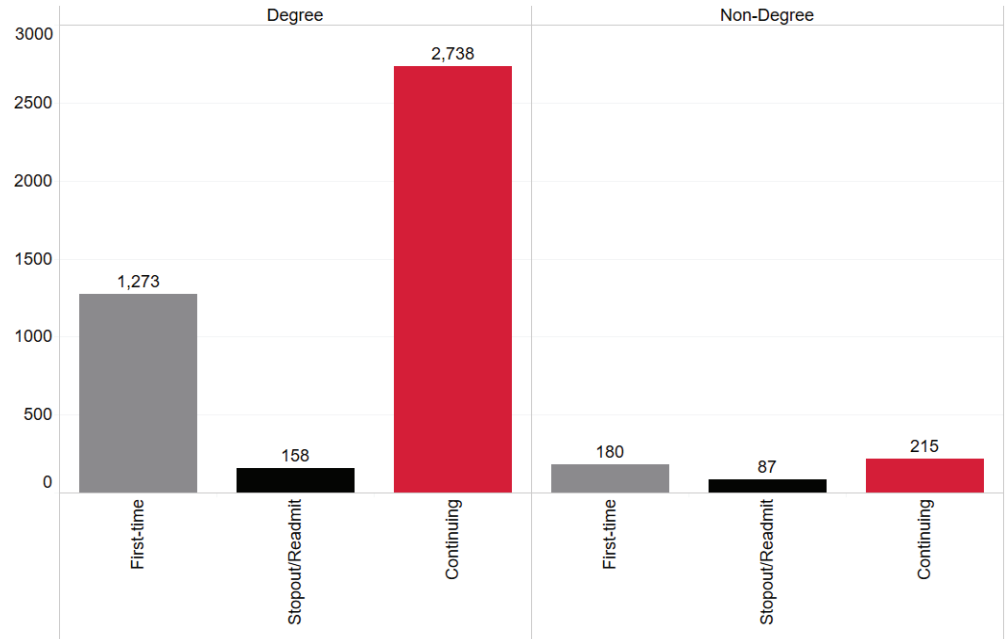

**Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Registration and Matriculation Status**

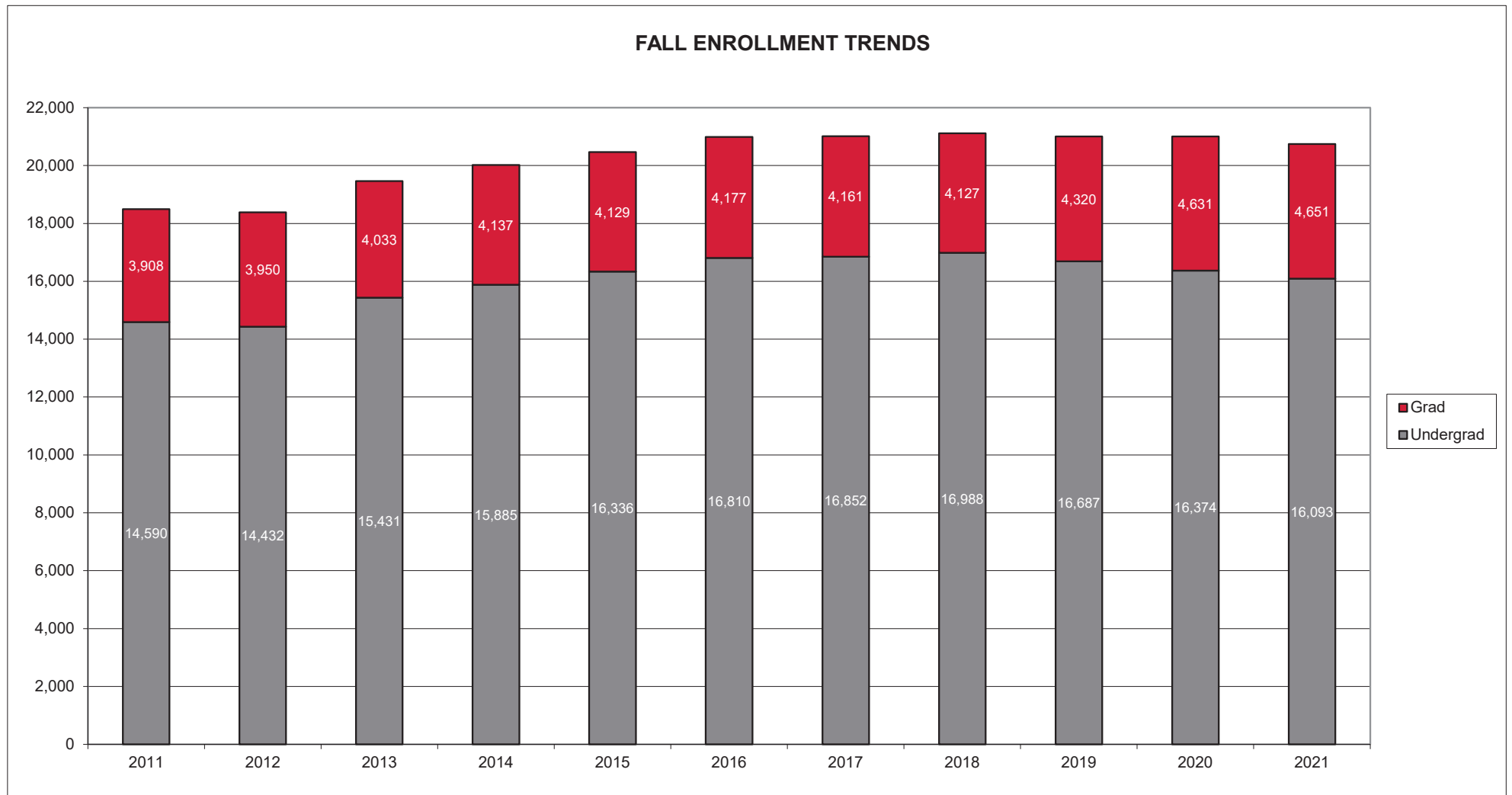

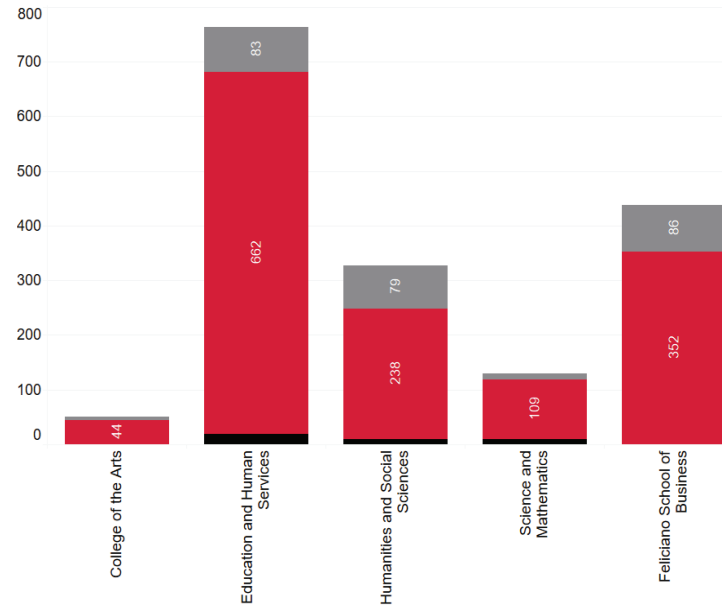

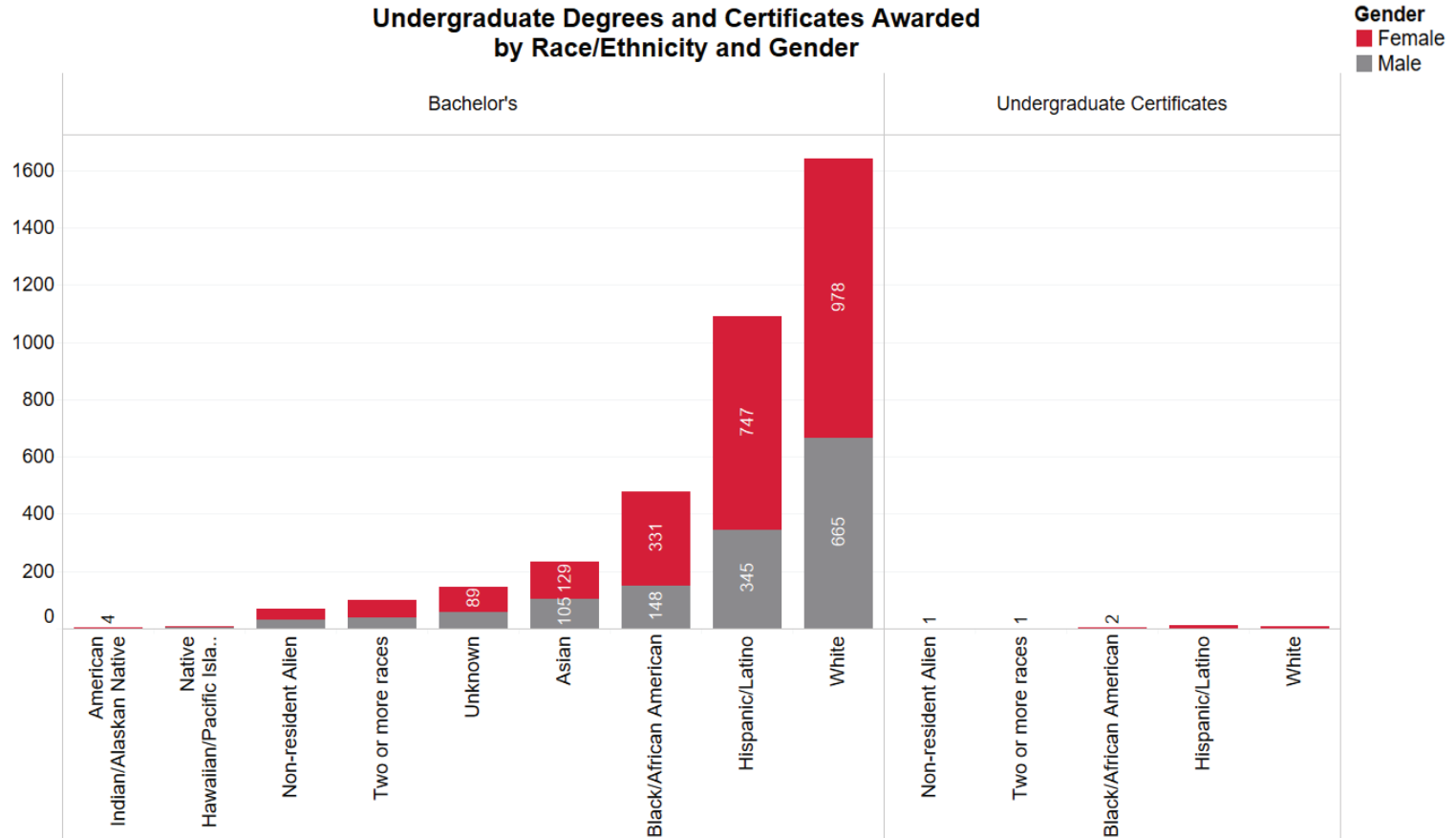

Undergraduate Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Race/Ethnicity and Gender



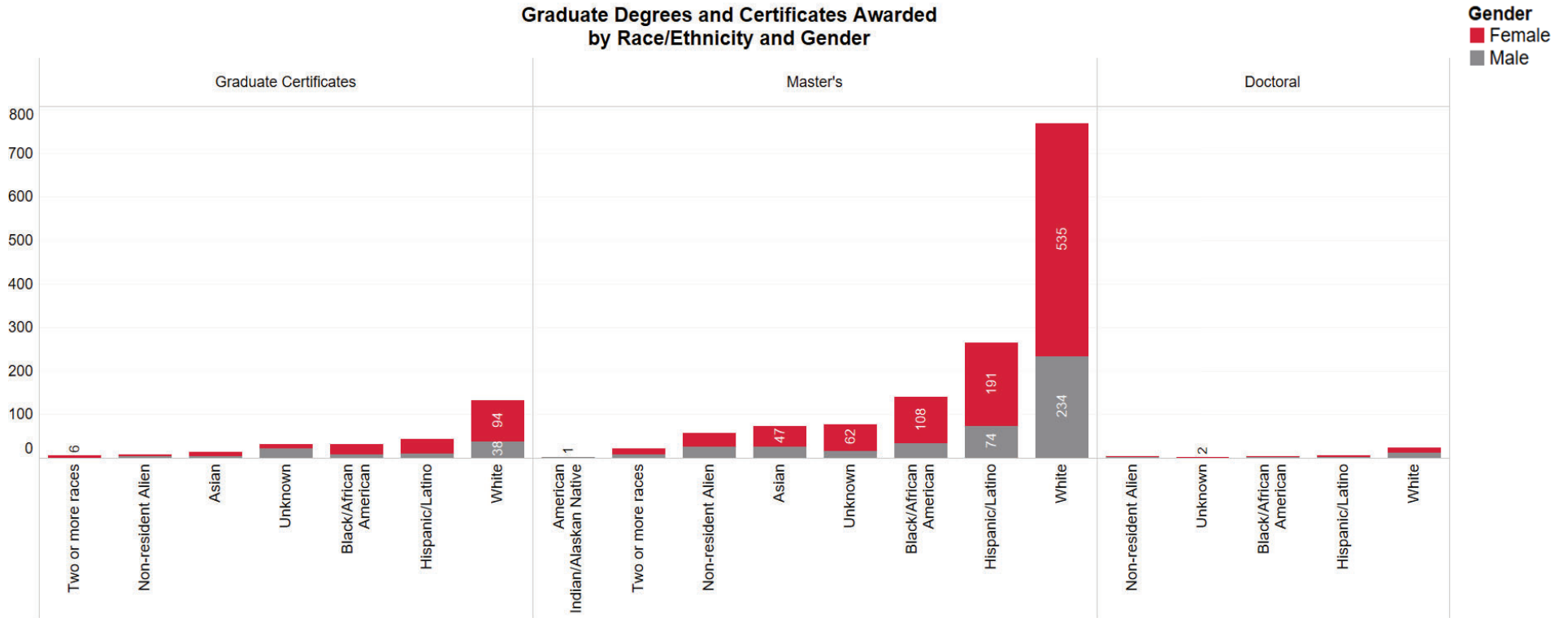

Graduate Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Race/Ethnicity and Gender



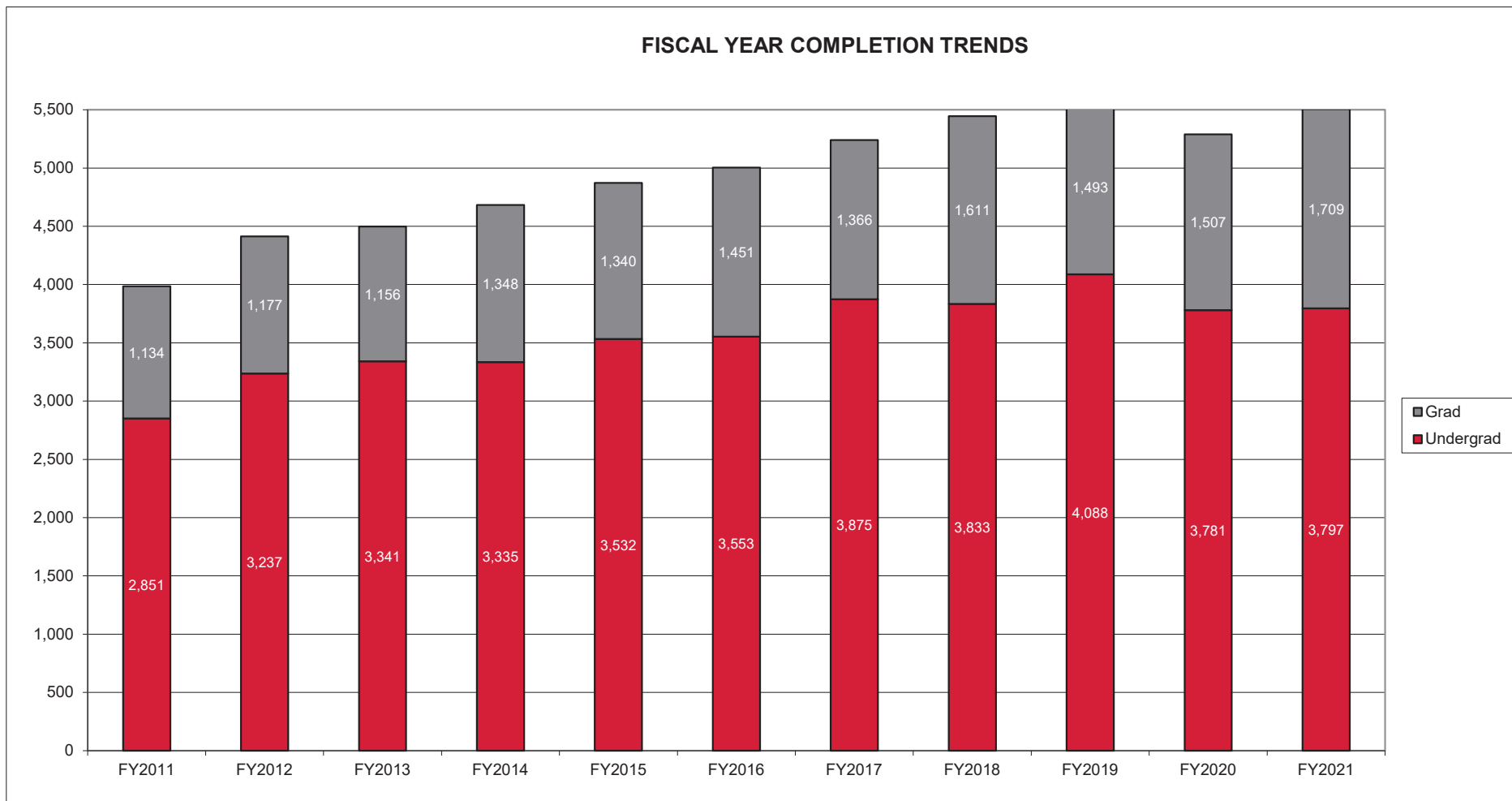

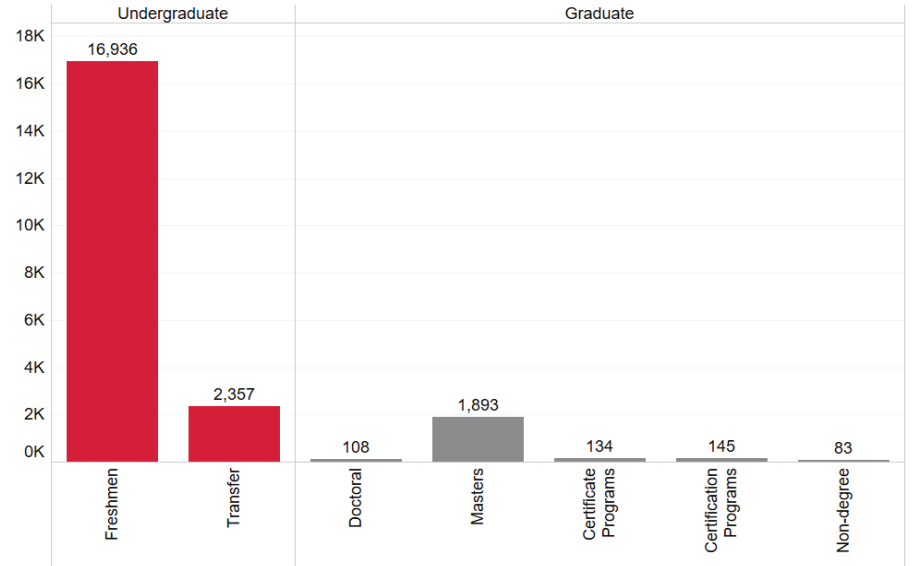

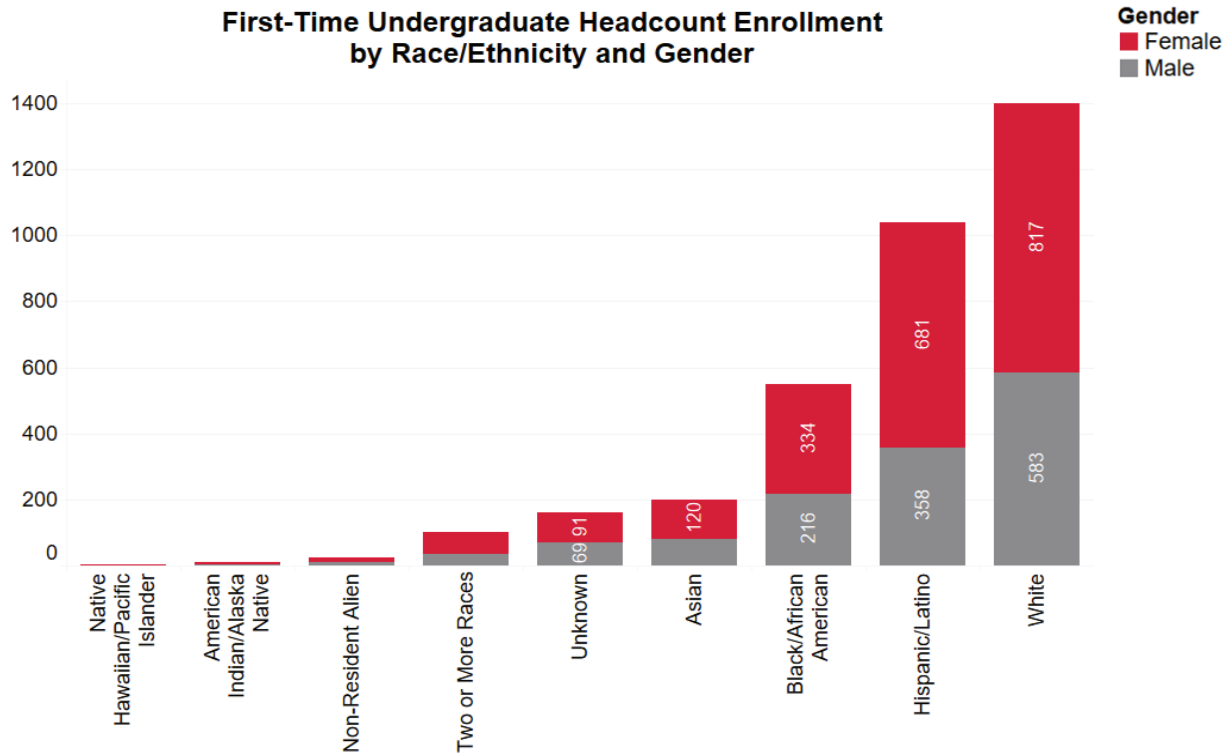

### First-Time Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Gender

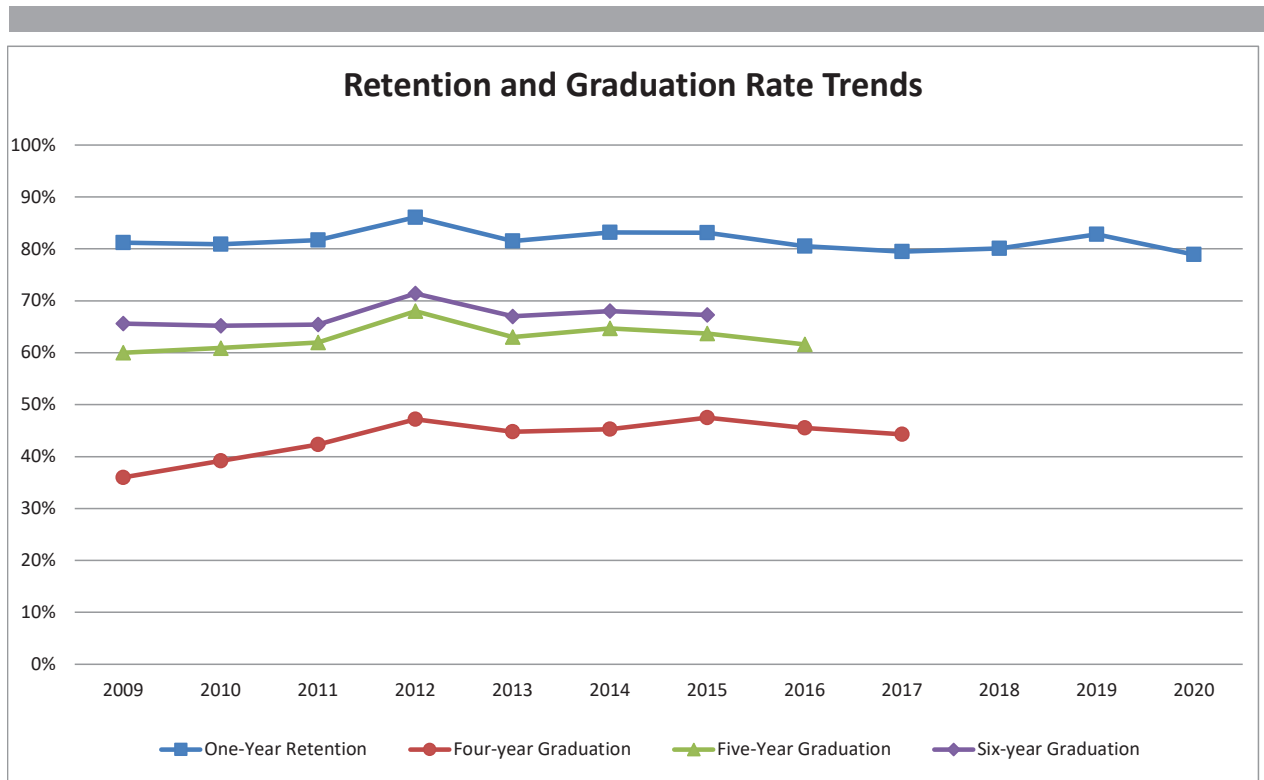

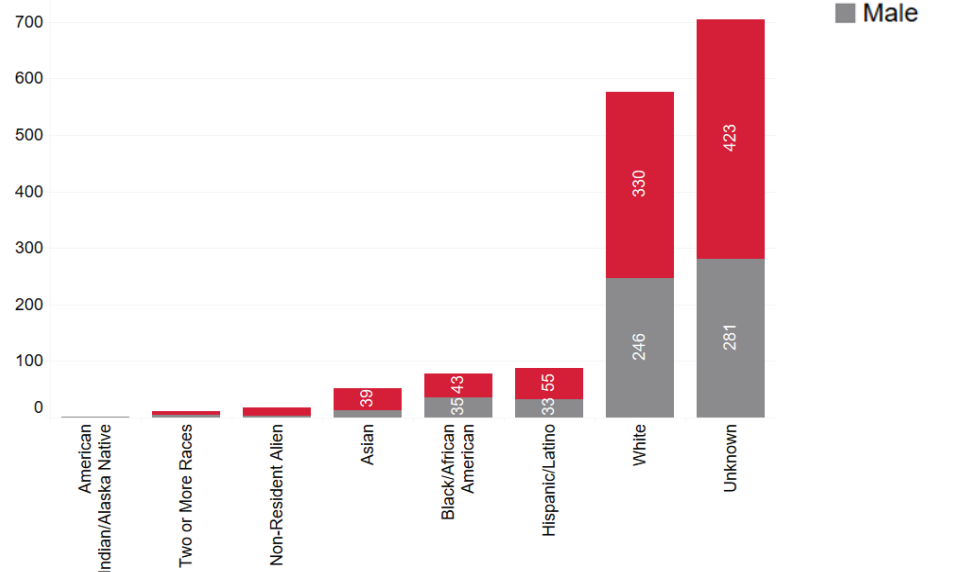

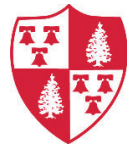
Full-Time Employee Headcount by Race/Ethnicity and Gender

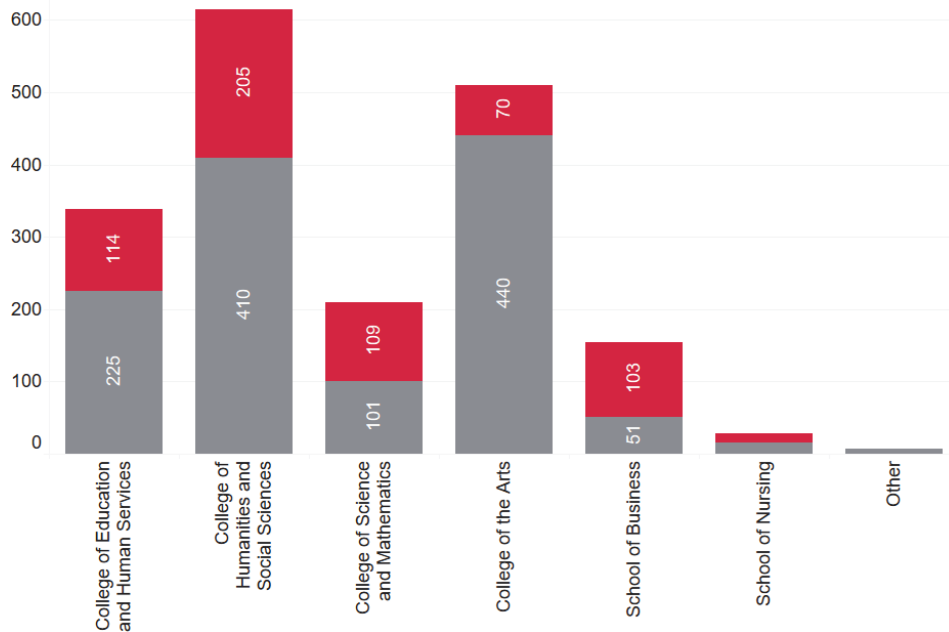
