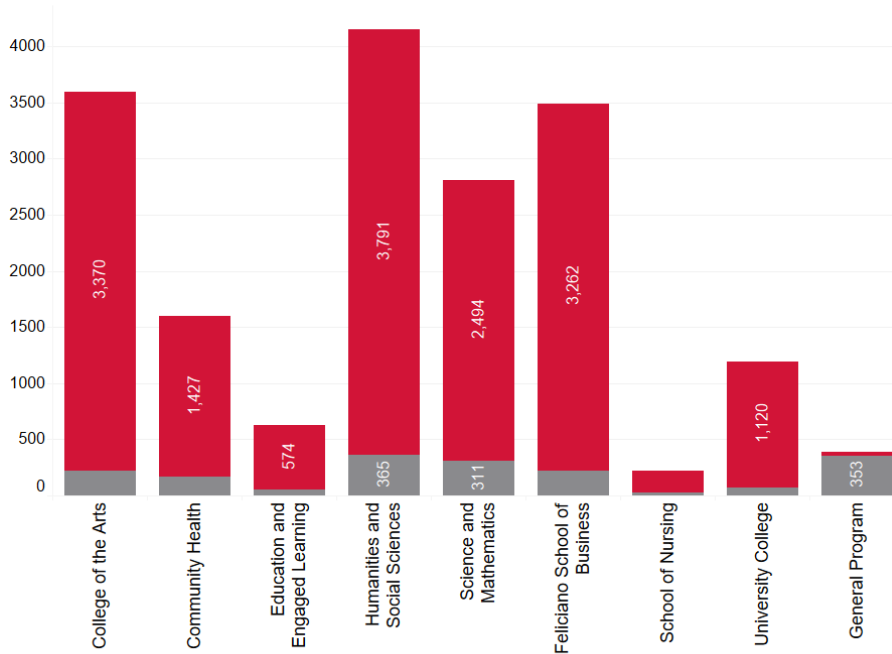

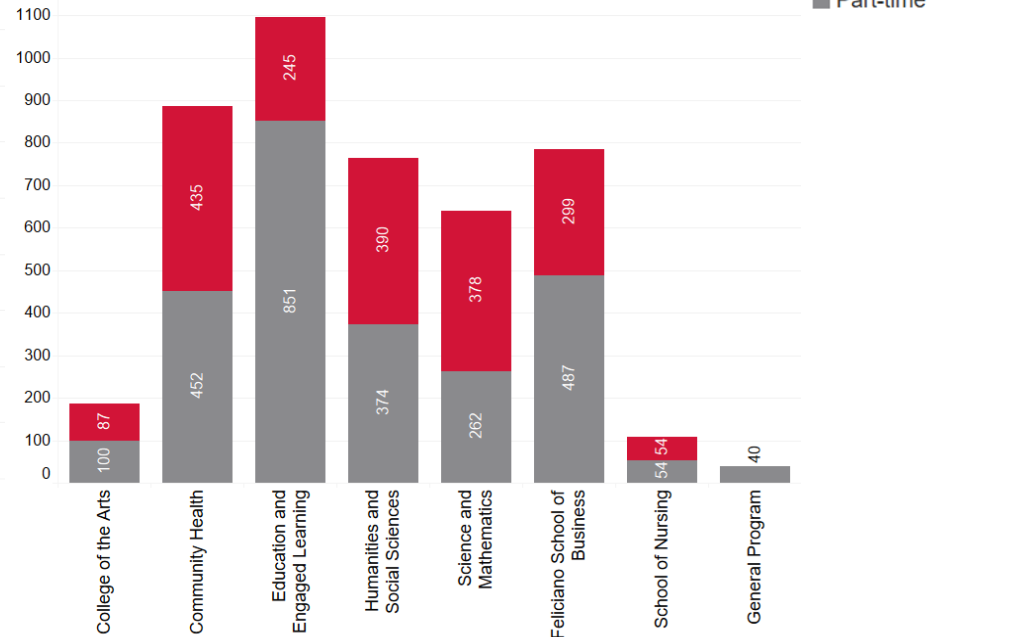

Graduate Headcount Enrollment by College and Attendance Status

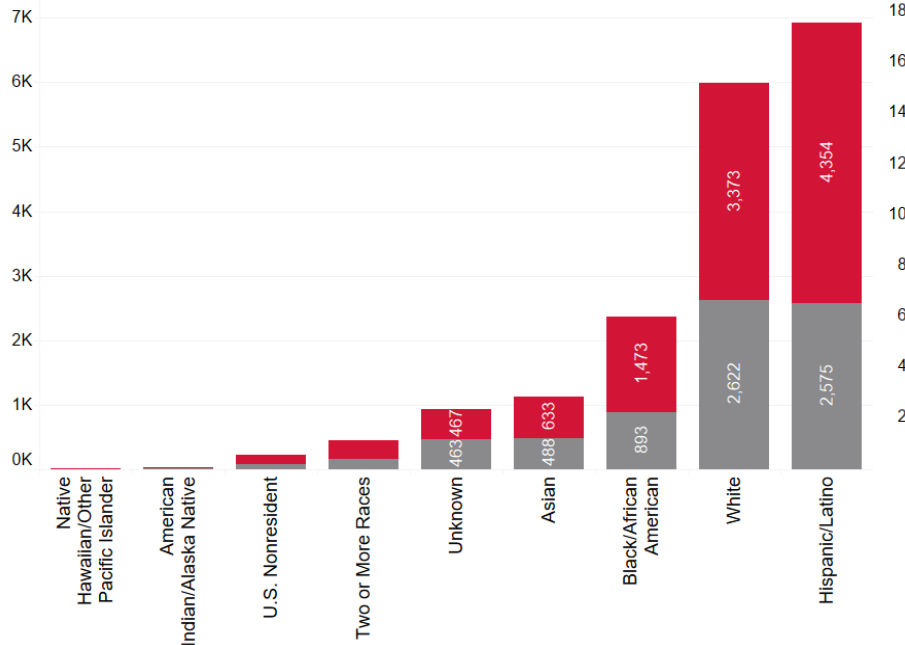

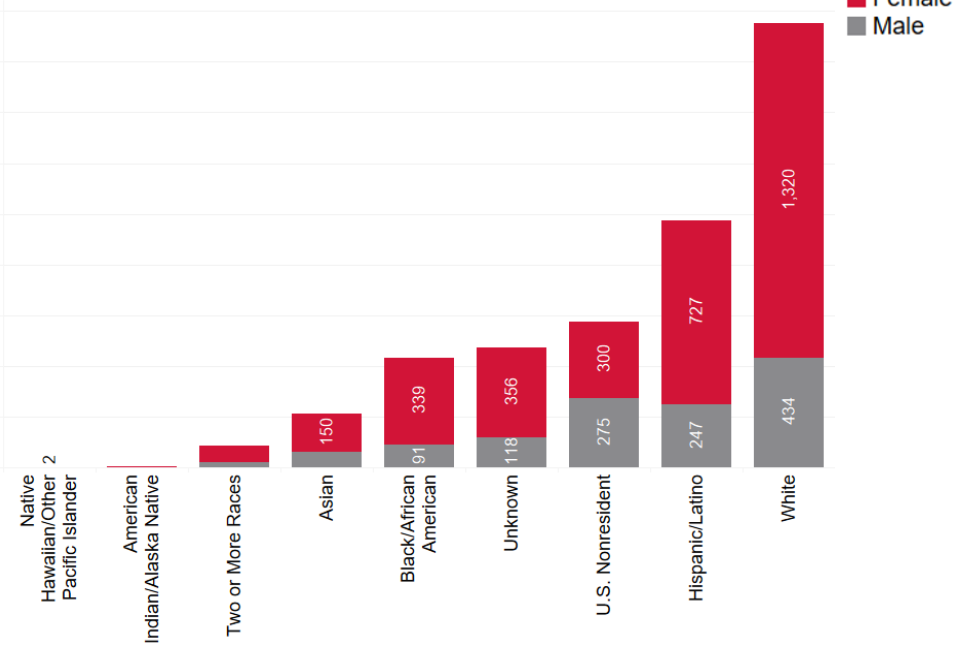

Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Sex

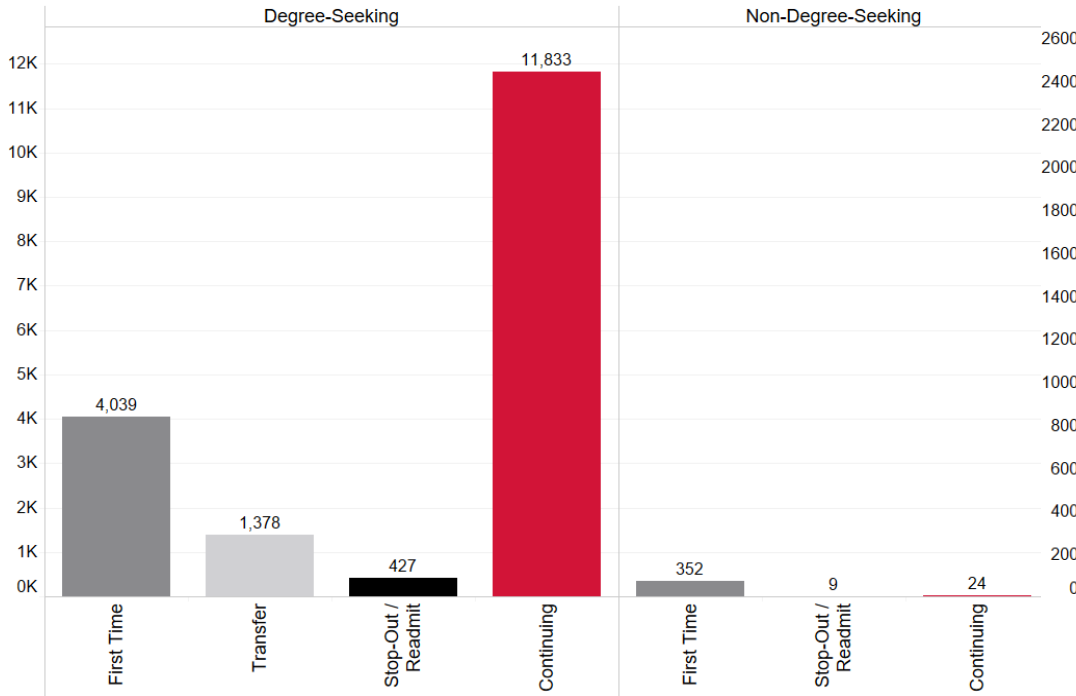

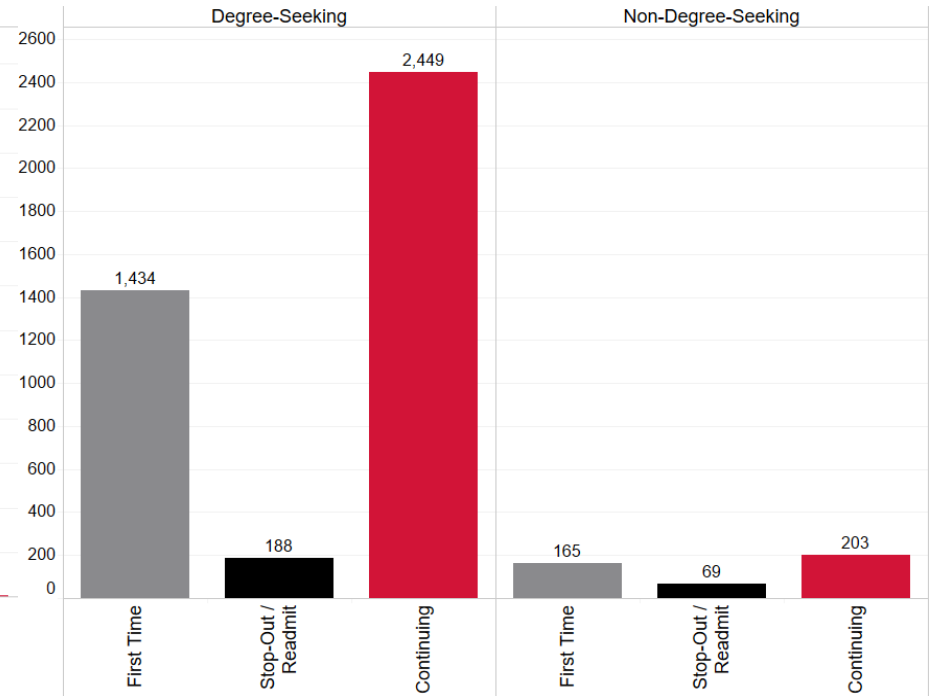

by Registration and Matriculation Status**



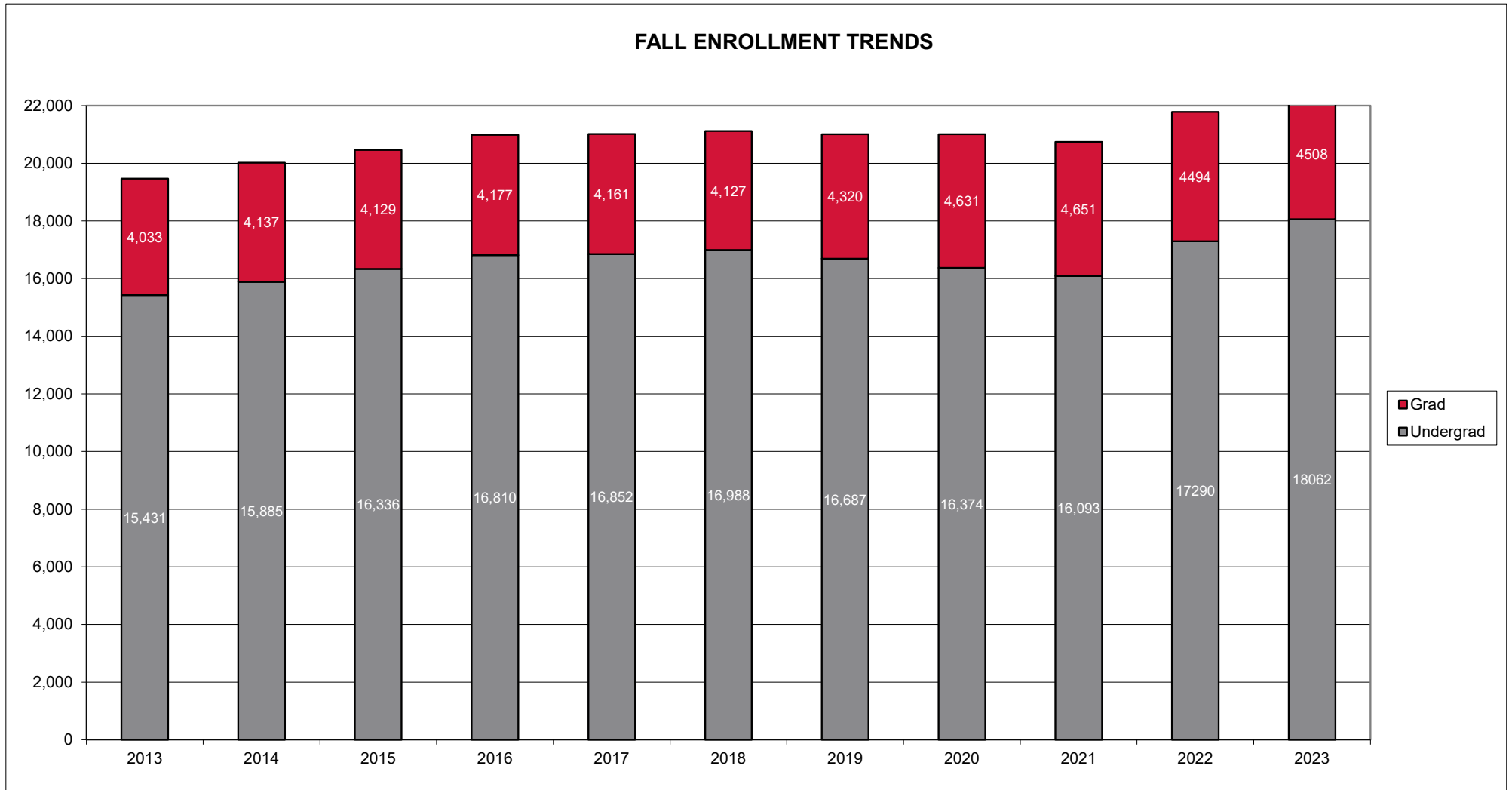
**Graduate Headcount Enrollment

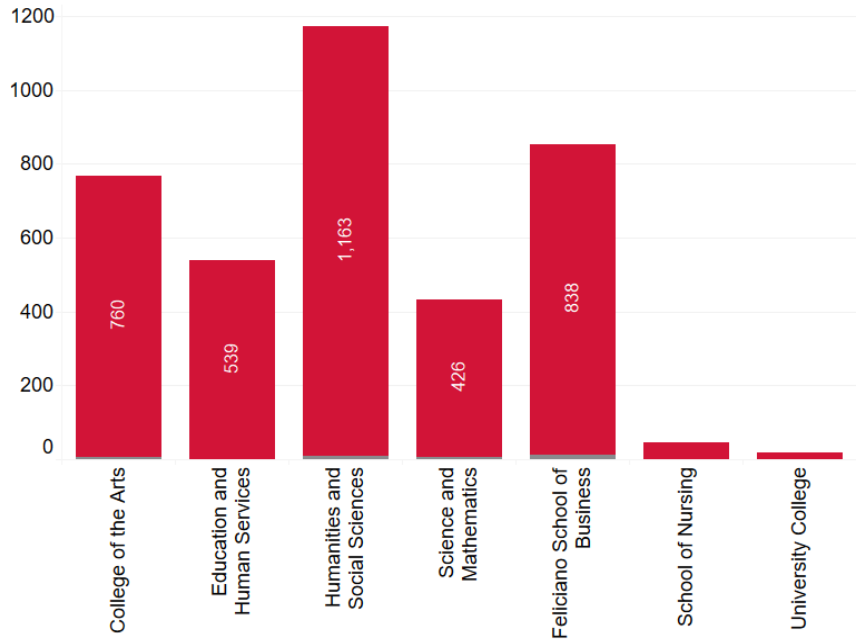

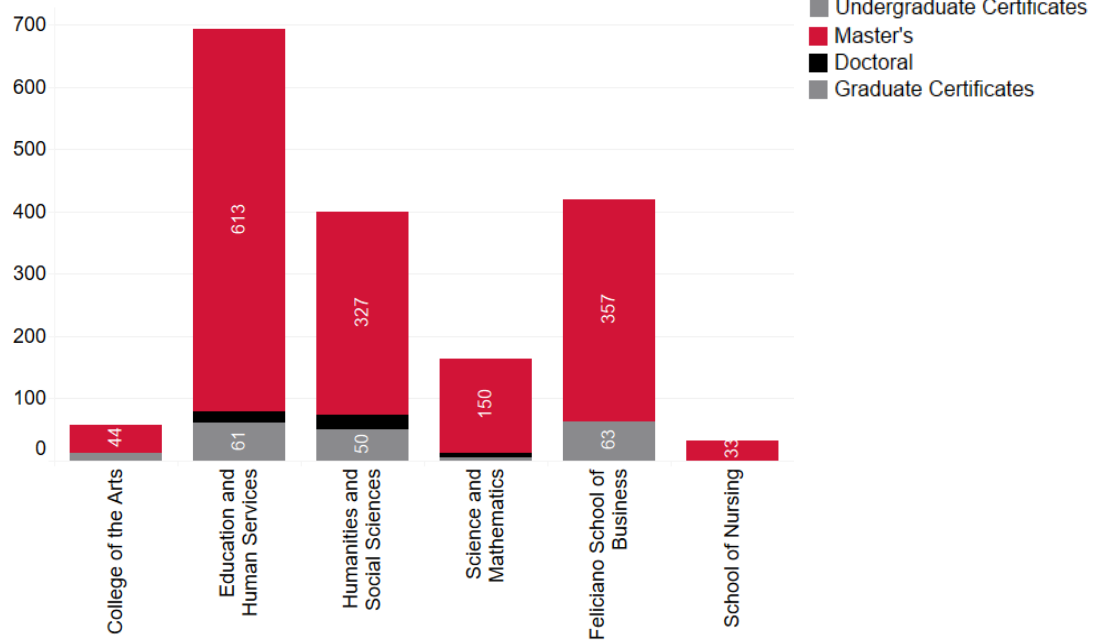

Graduate Degrees and Certificates Awarded by College/School



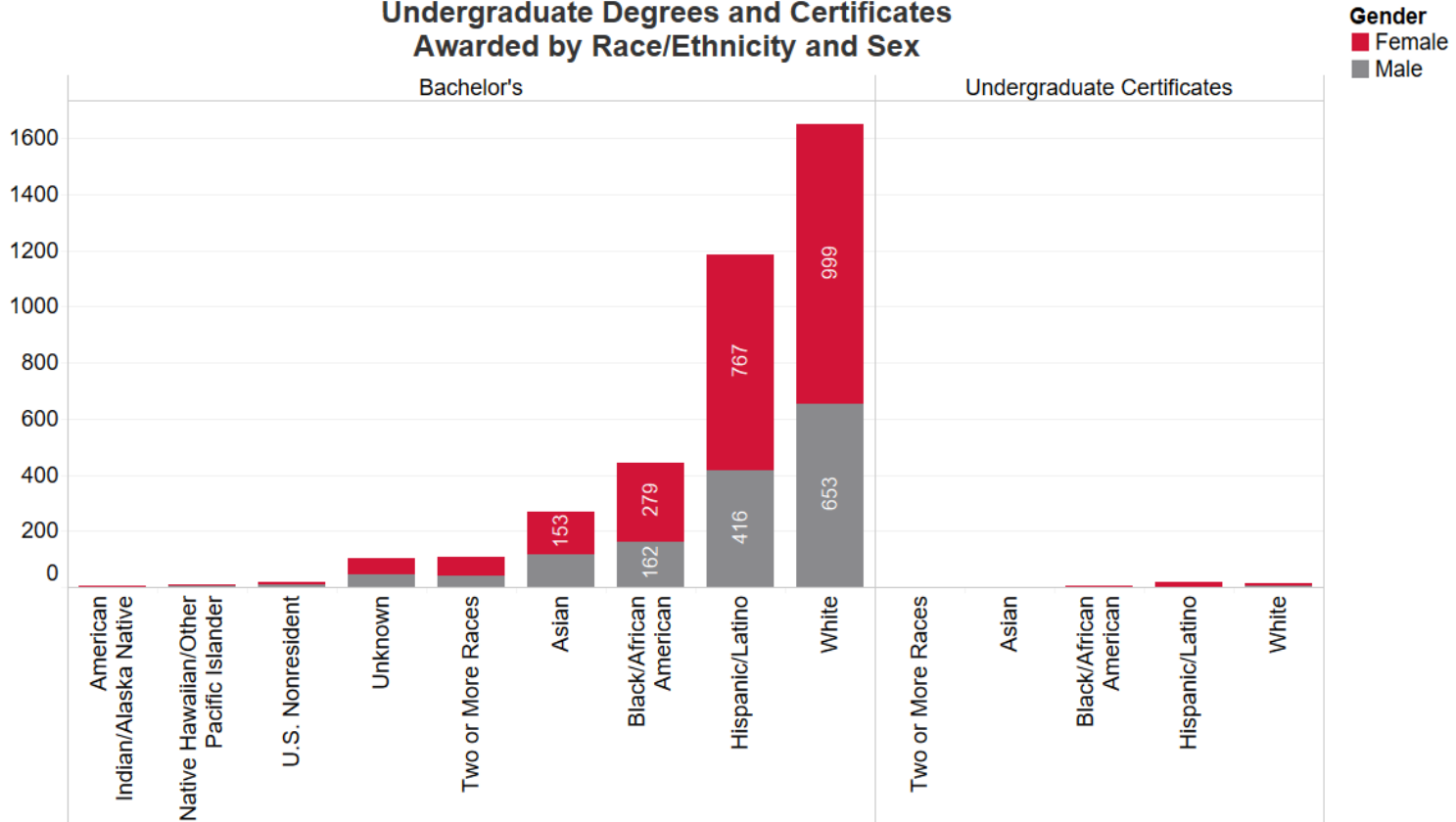

Undergraduate Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Race/Ethnicity and Sex



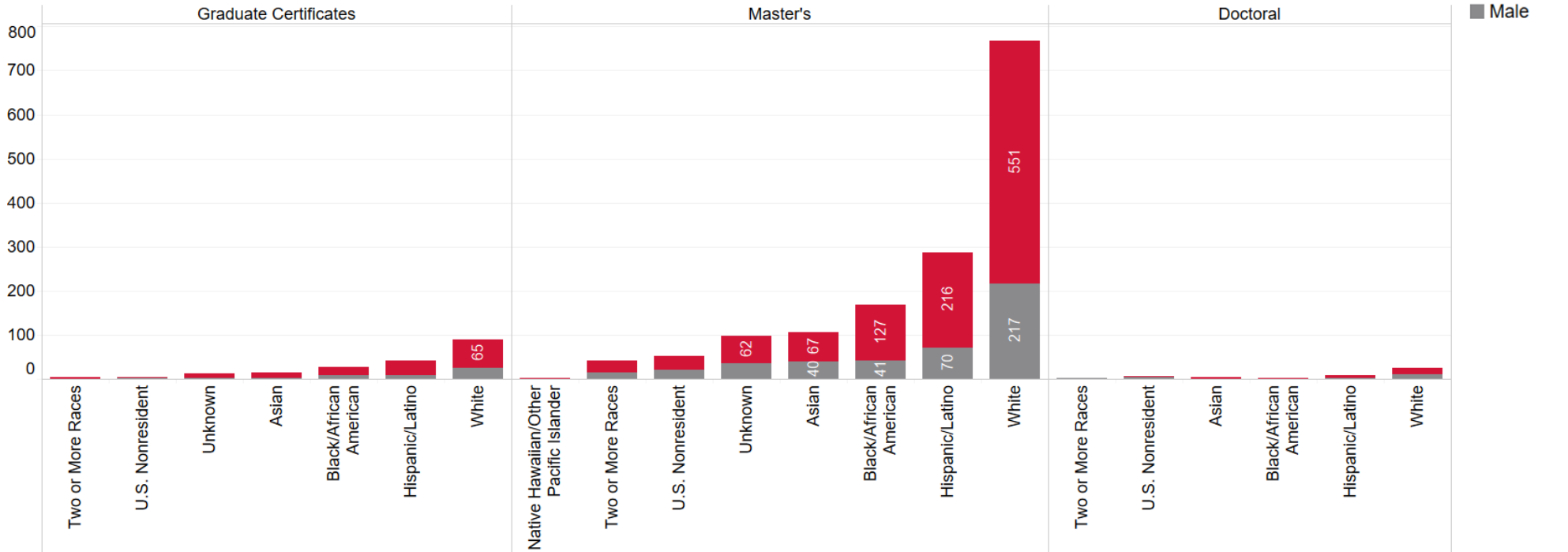

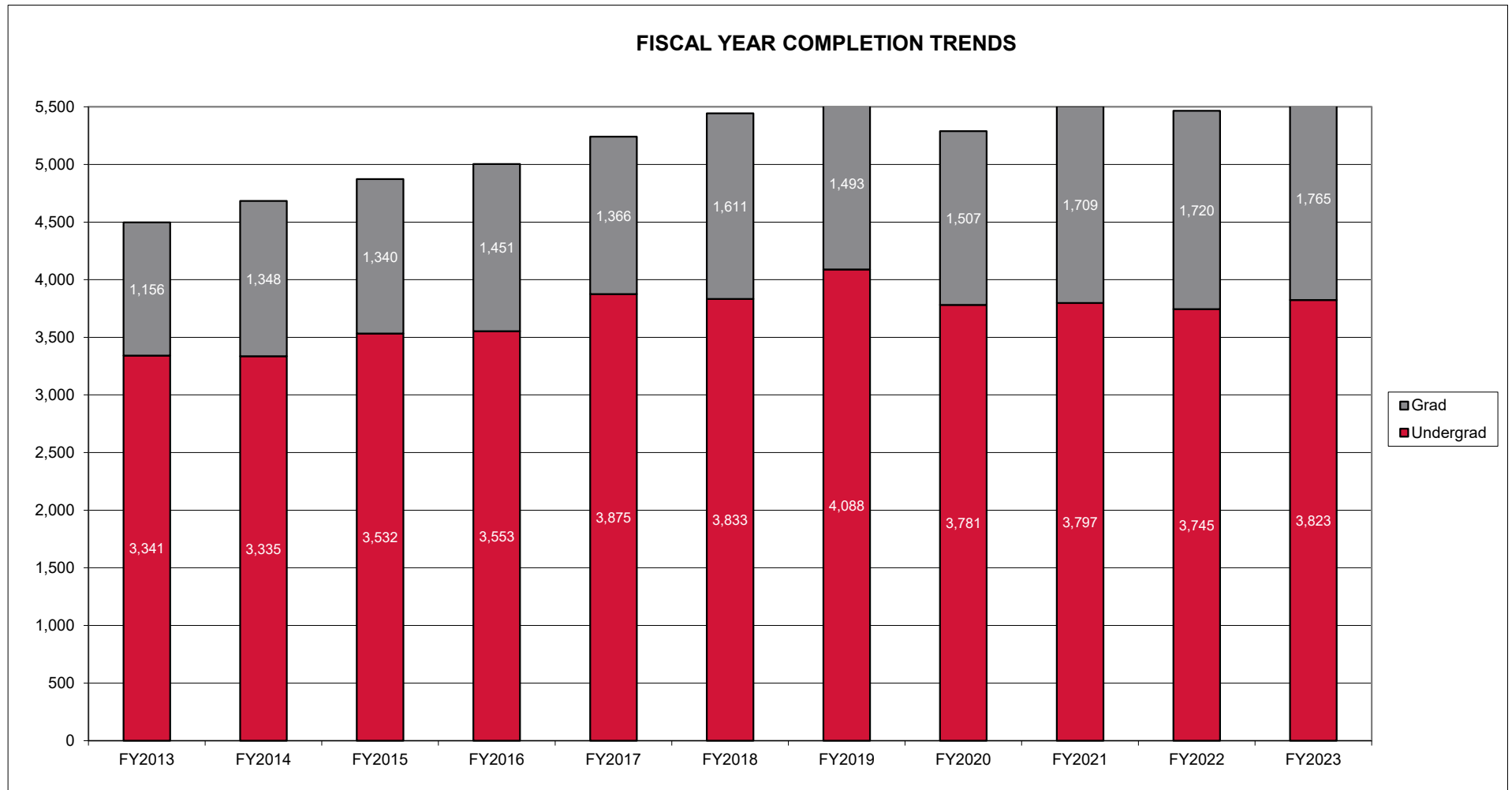

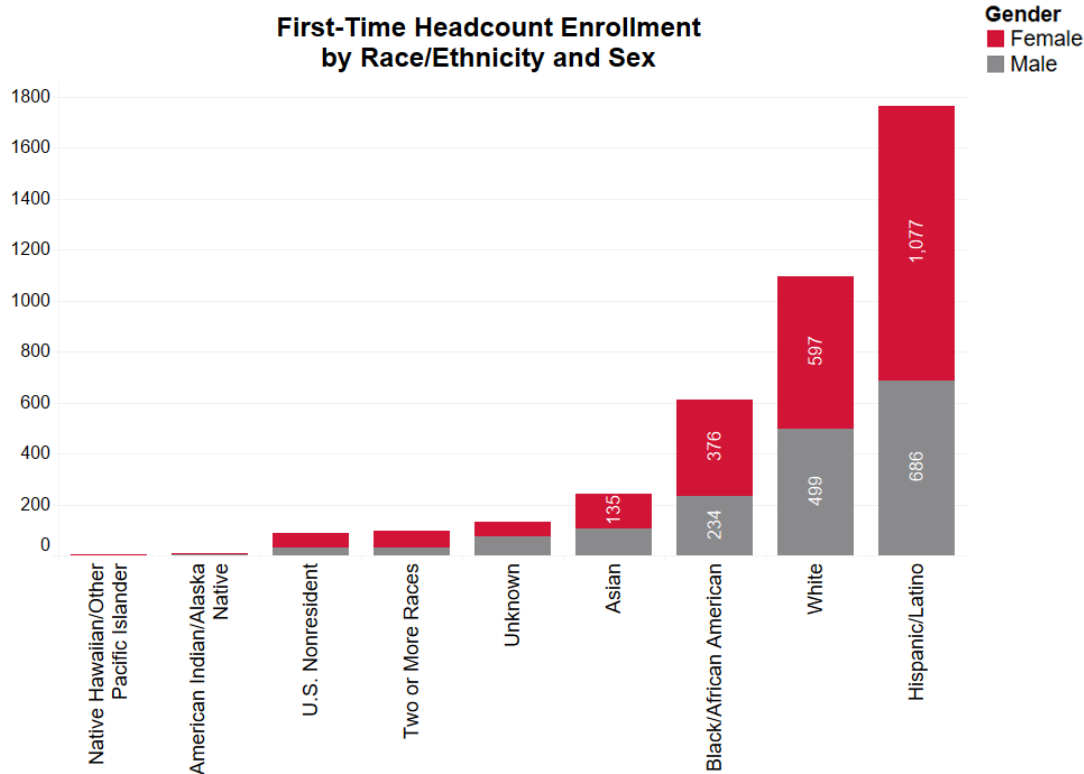

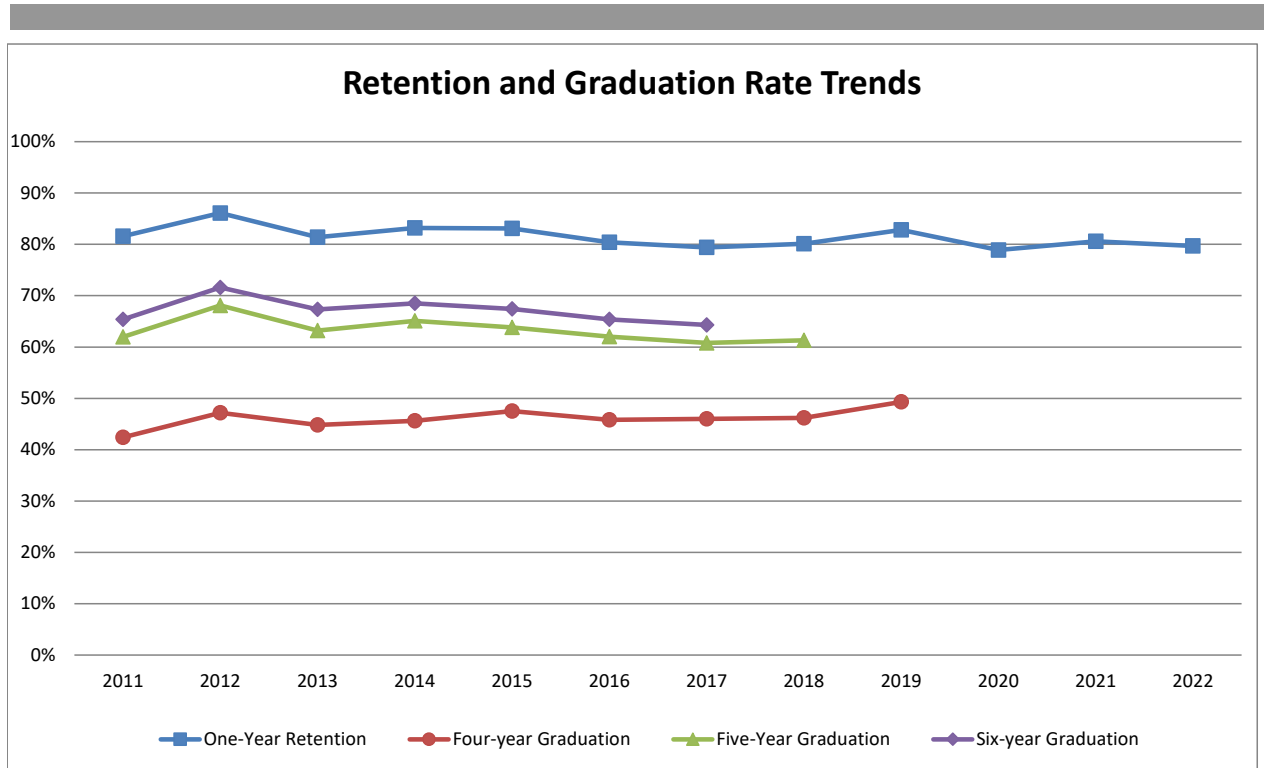
### First-Time Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Sex

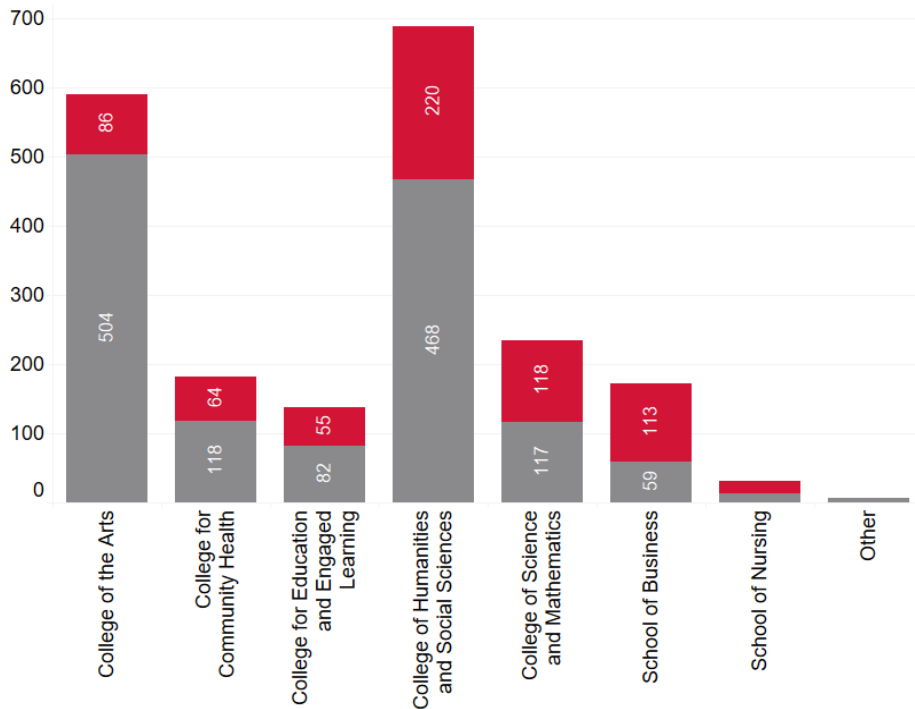
