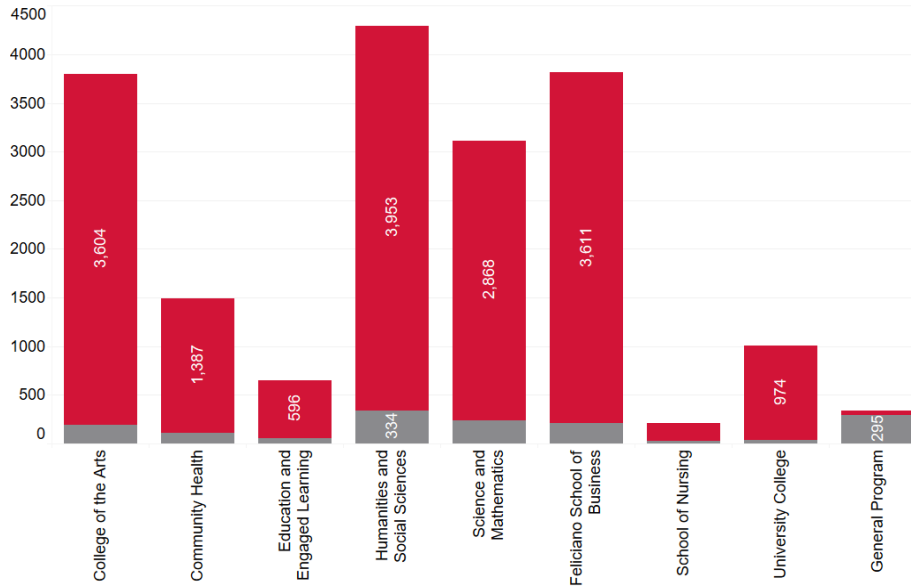

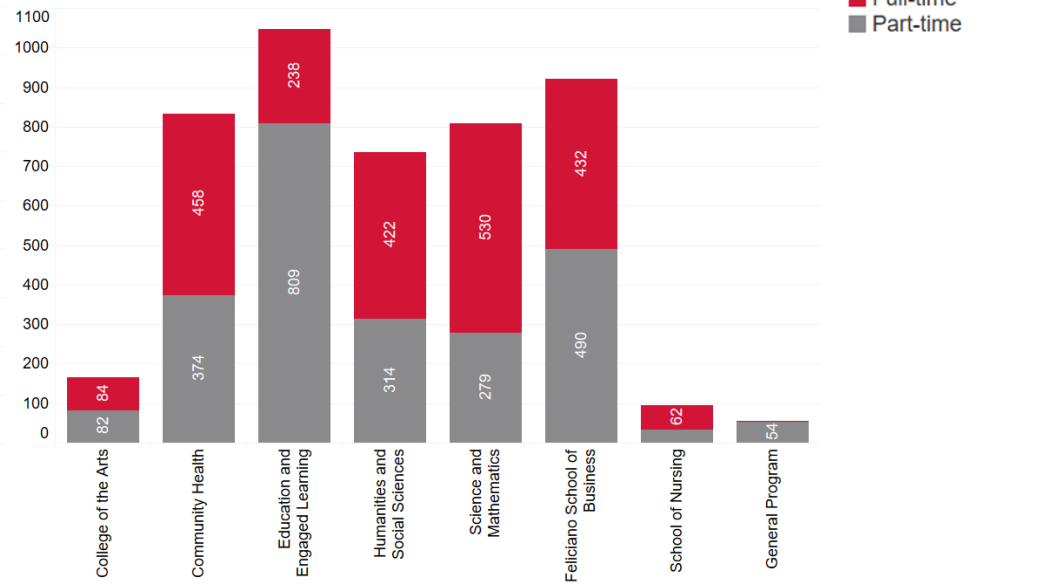

**Graduate Headcount Enrollment by College and Attendance Status**

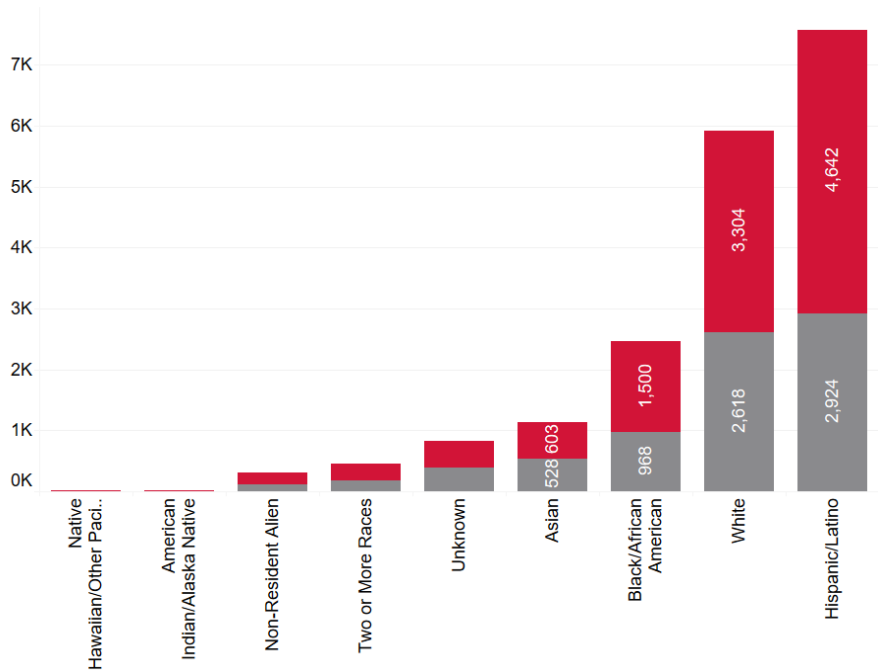

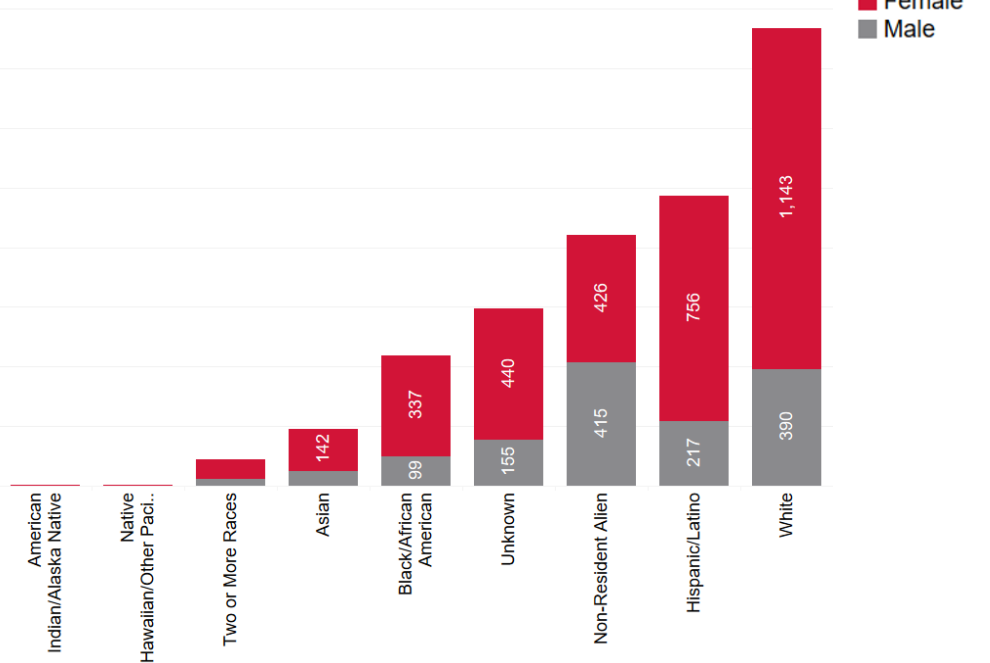

Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Sex

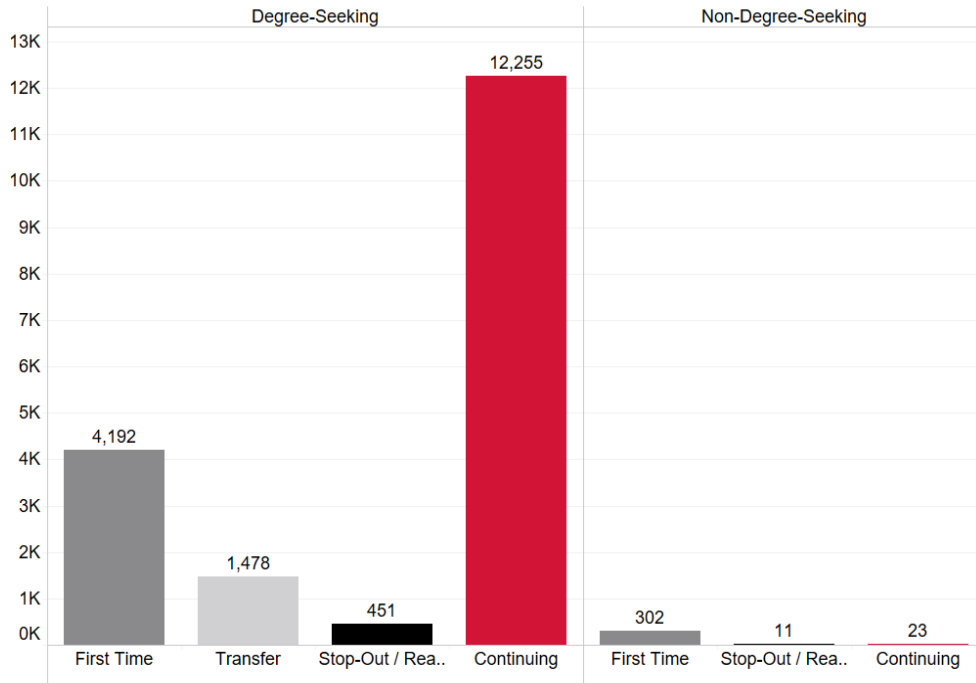

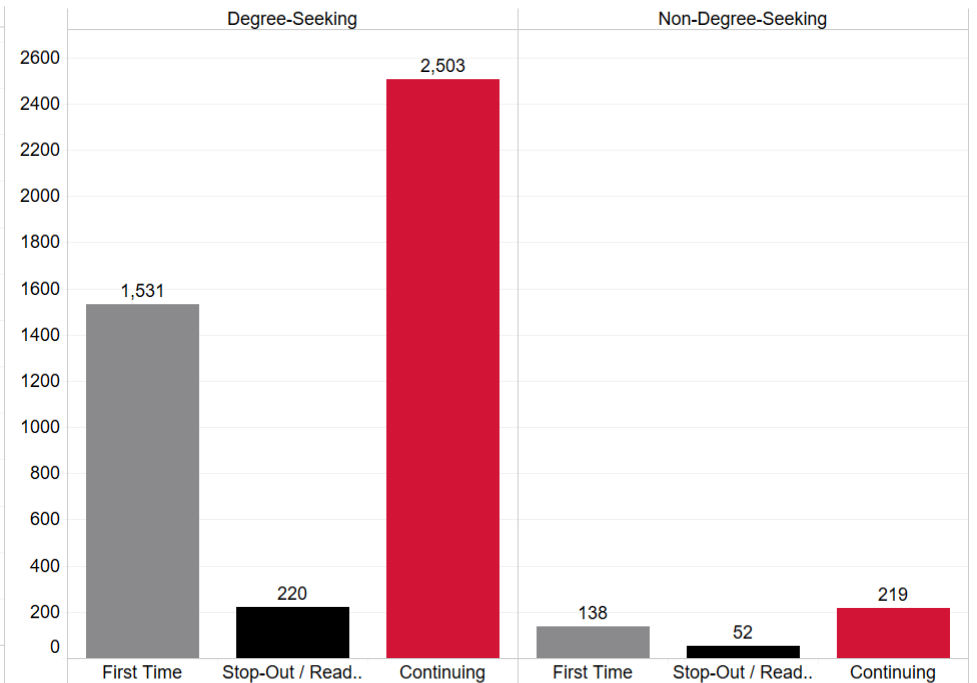

by Registration and Matriculation Status**



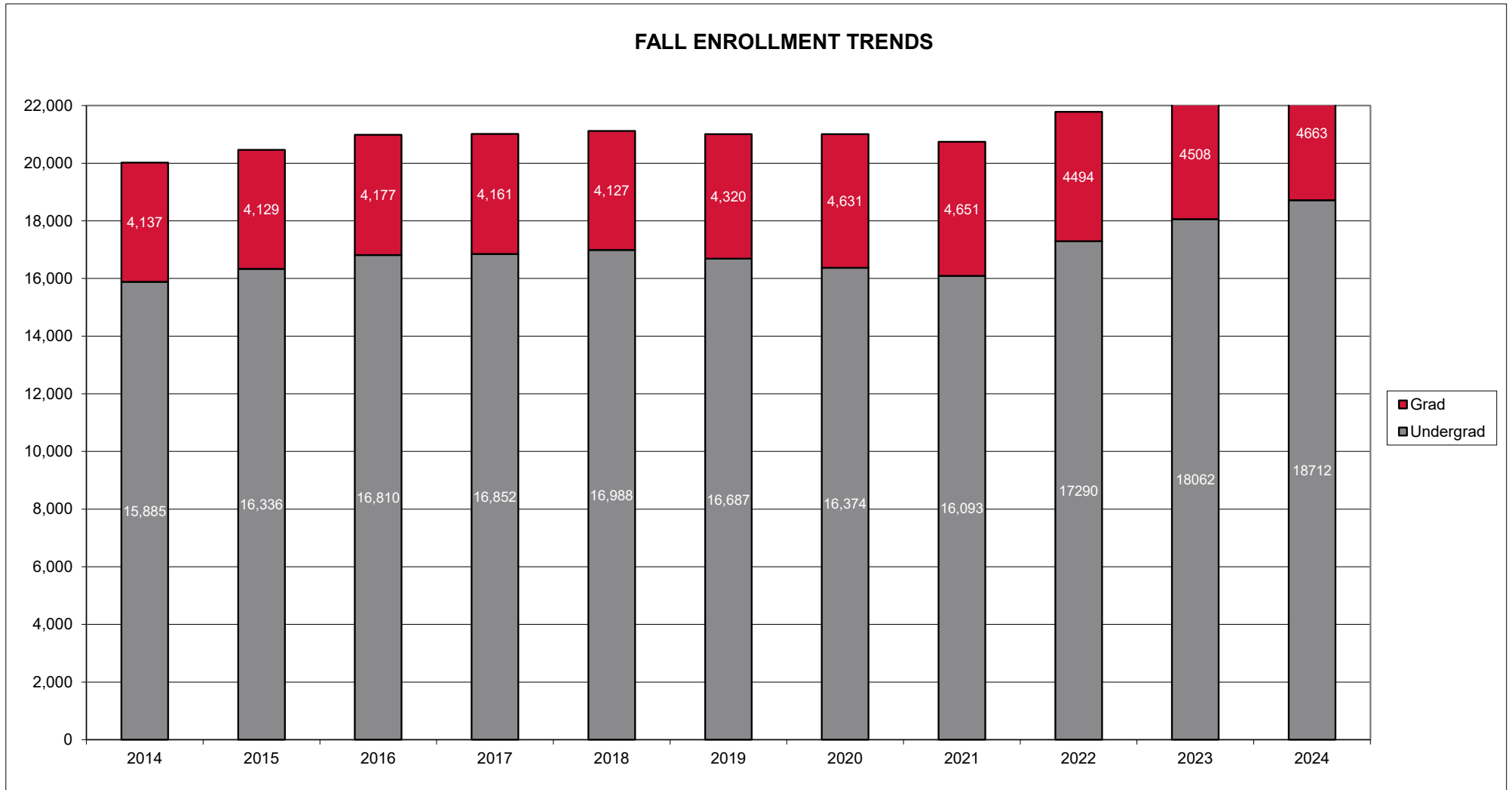
**Graduate Headcount Enrollment

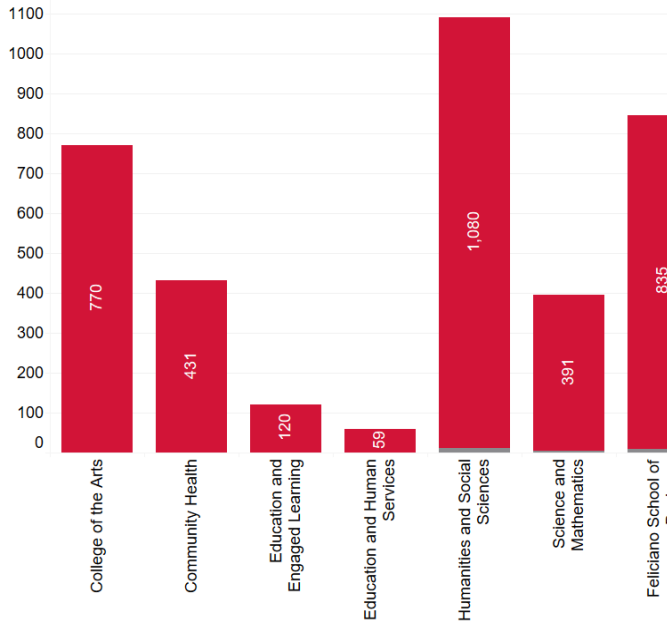

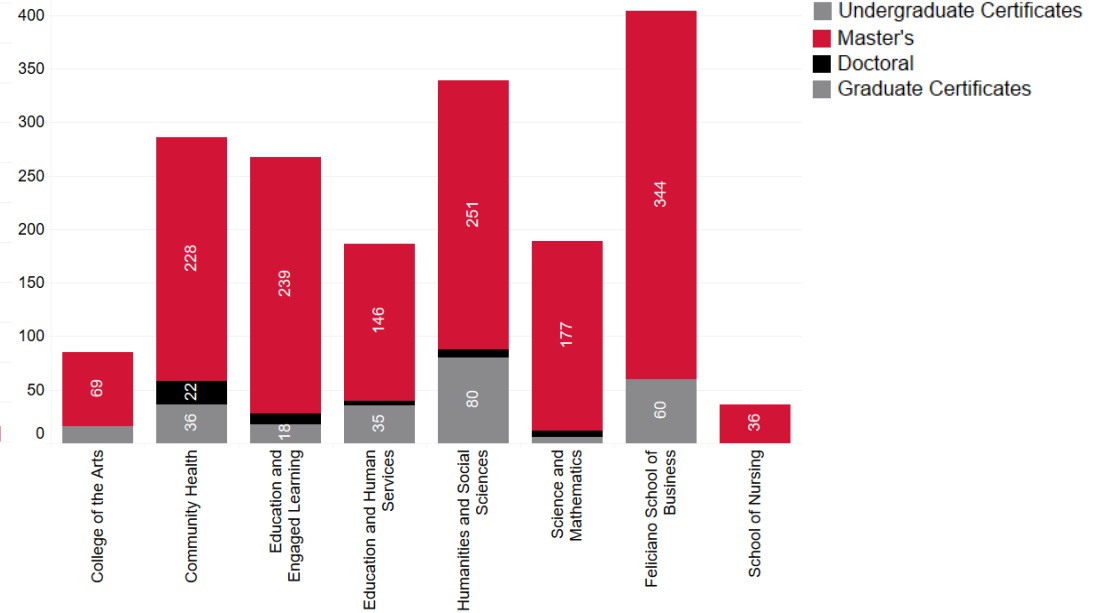

Awarded by College/School**

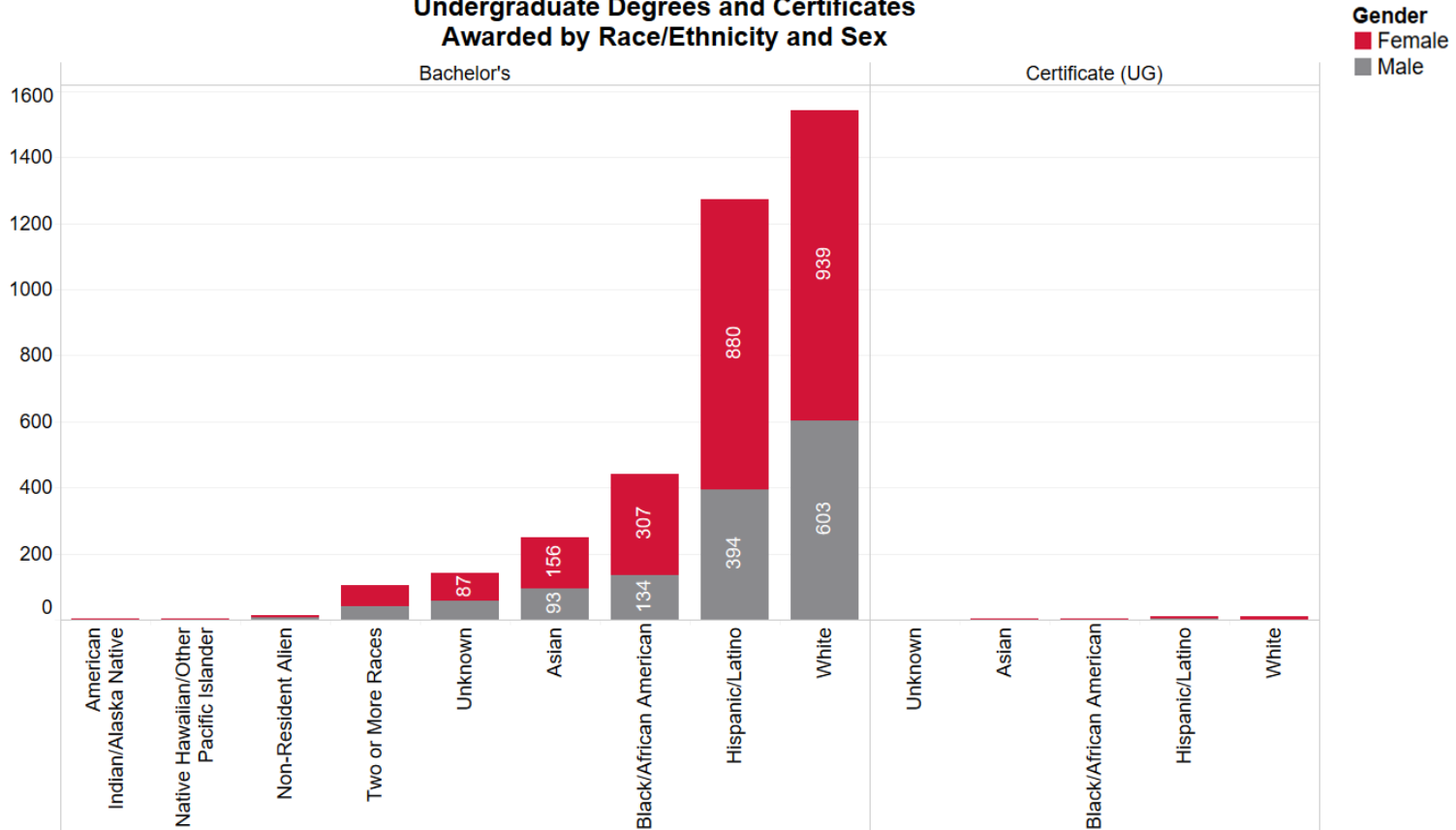

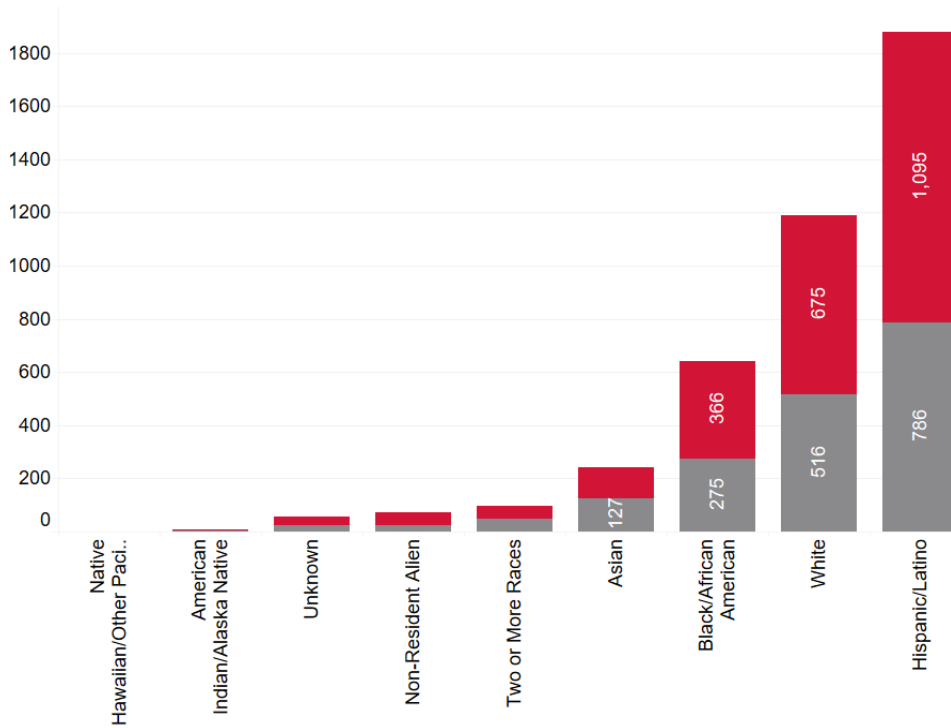

### First-Time Headcount Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Sex

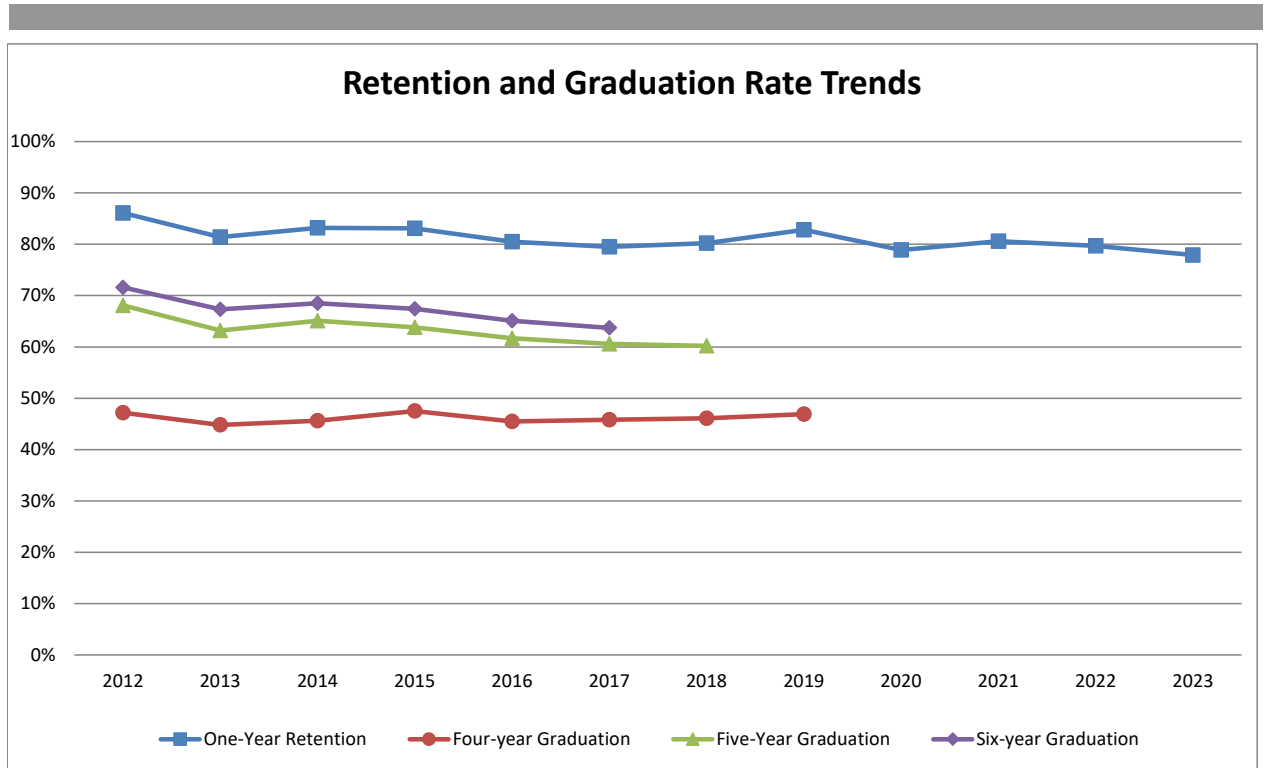

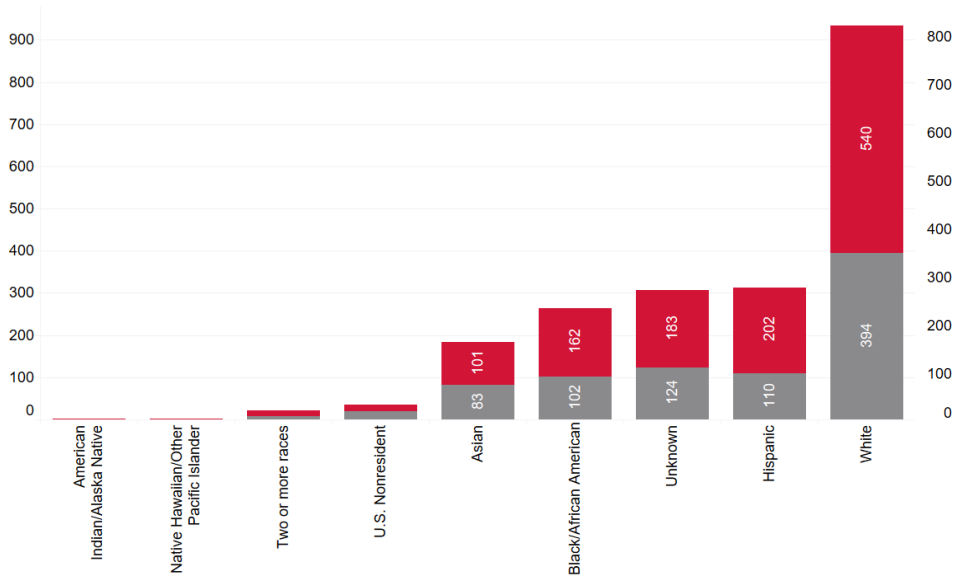

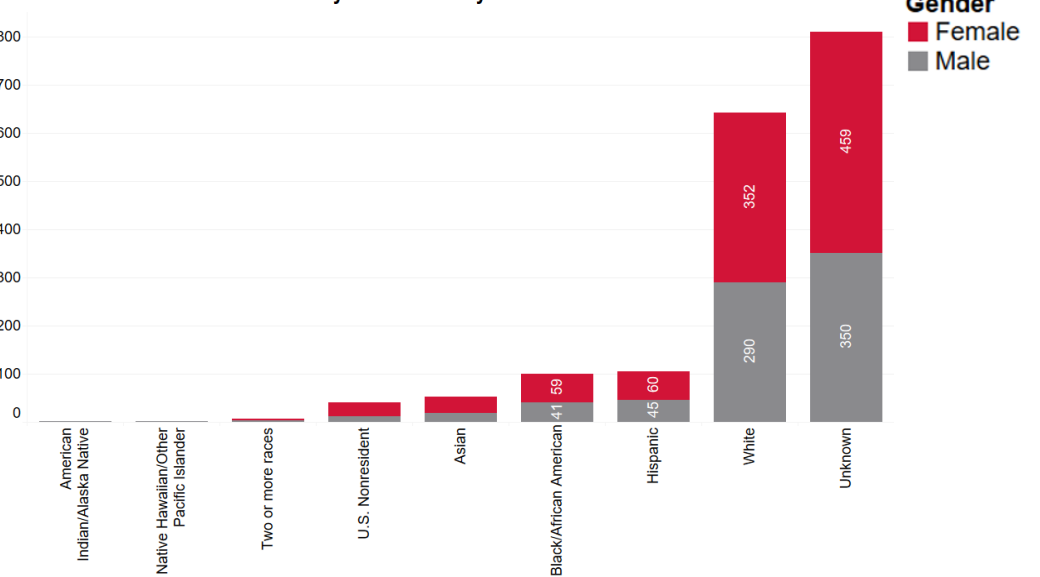

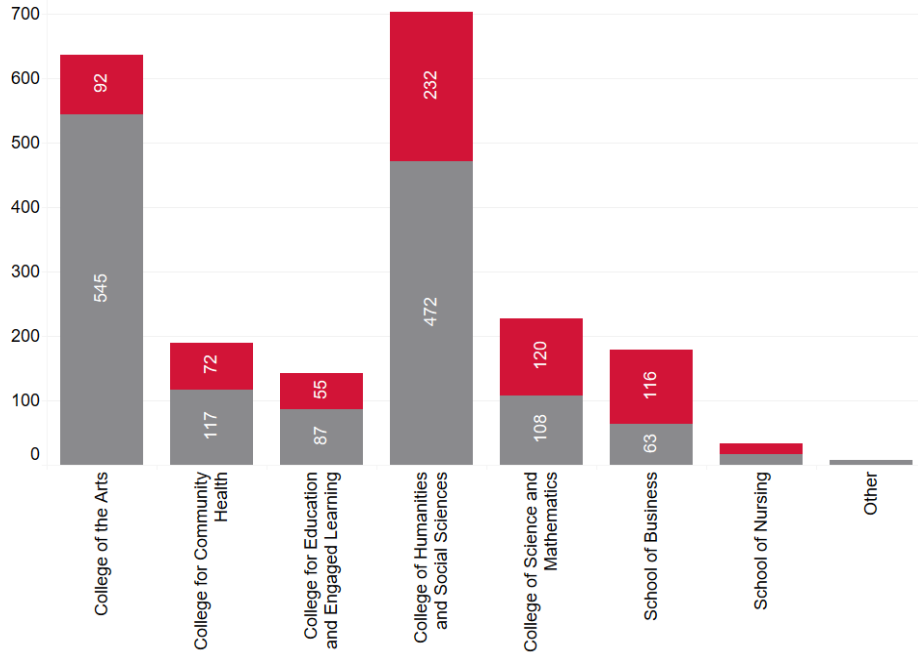
