

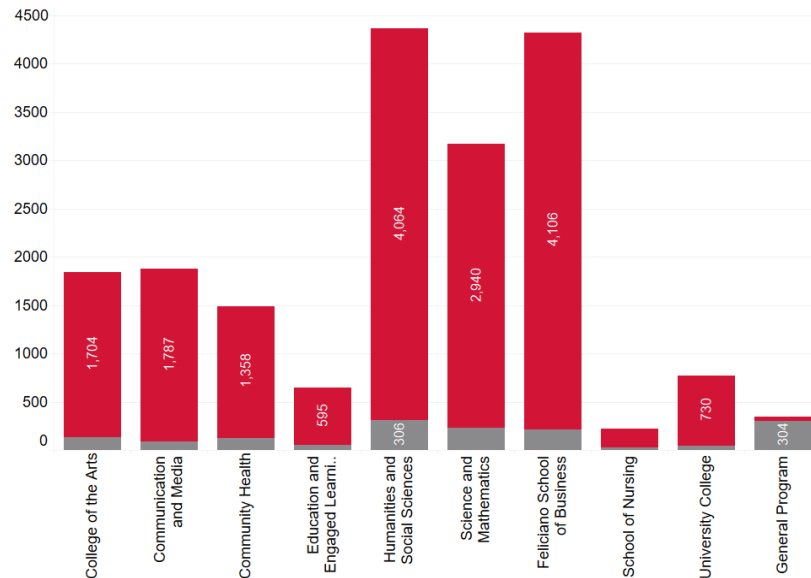

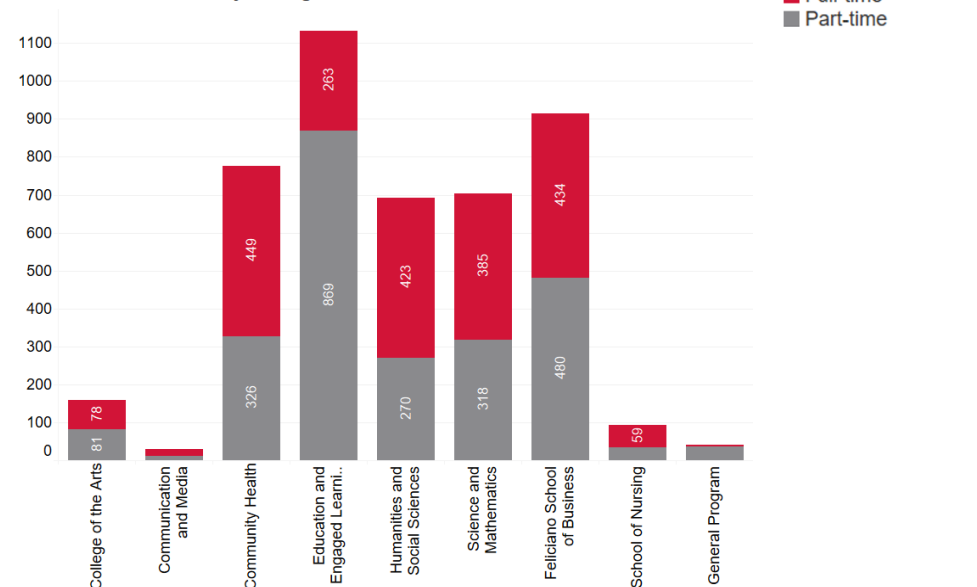

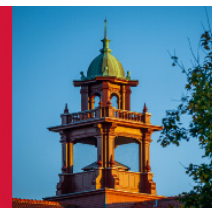

by College and Attendance Status



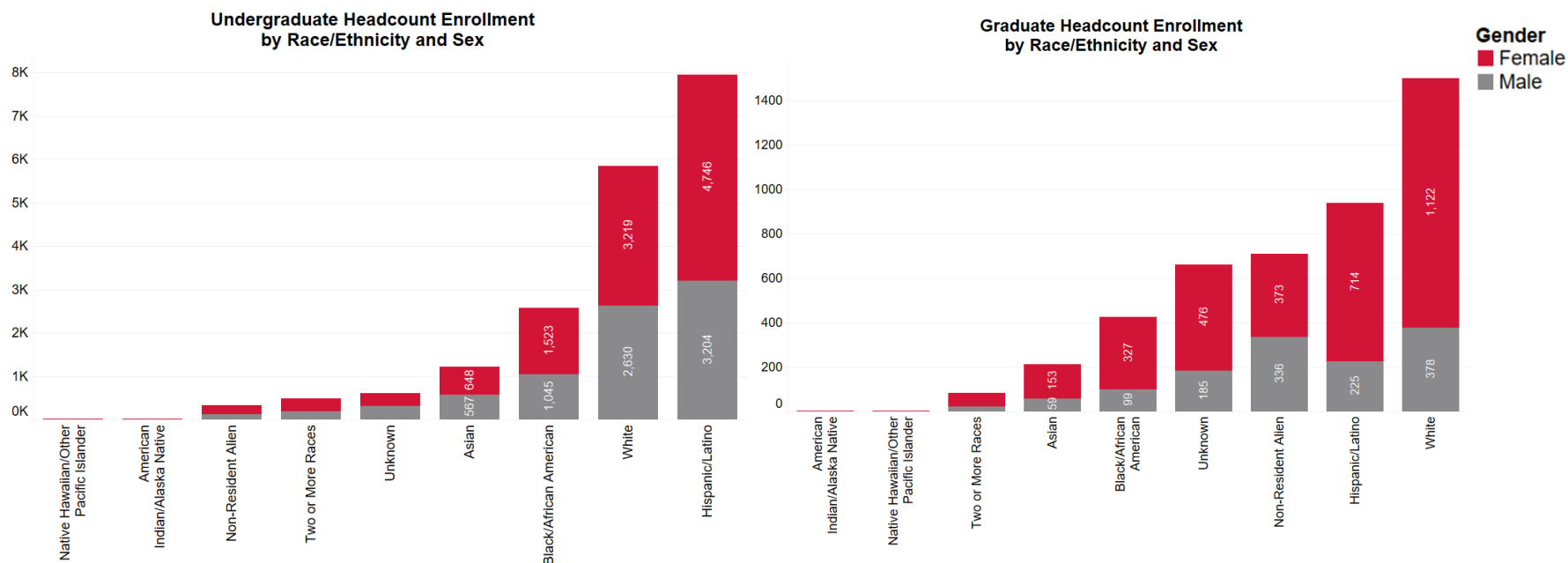
Graduate Headcount Enrollment

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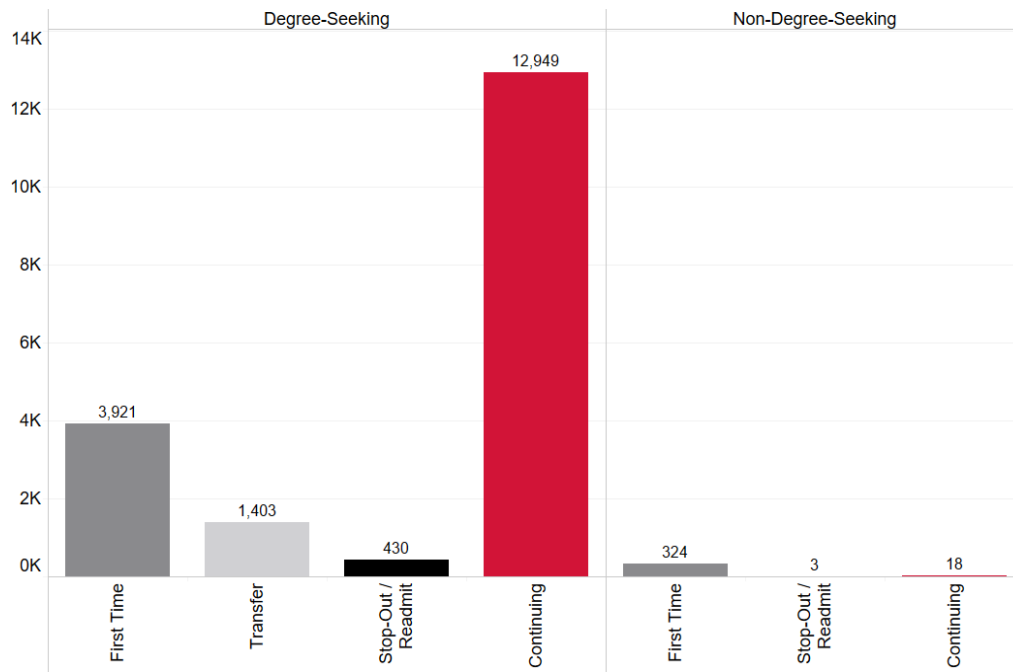

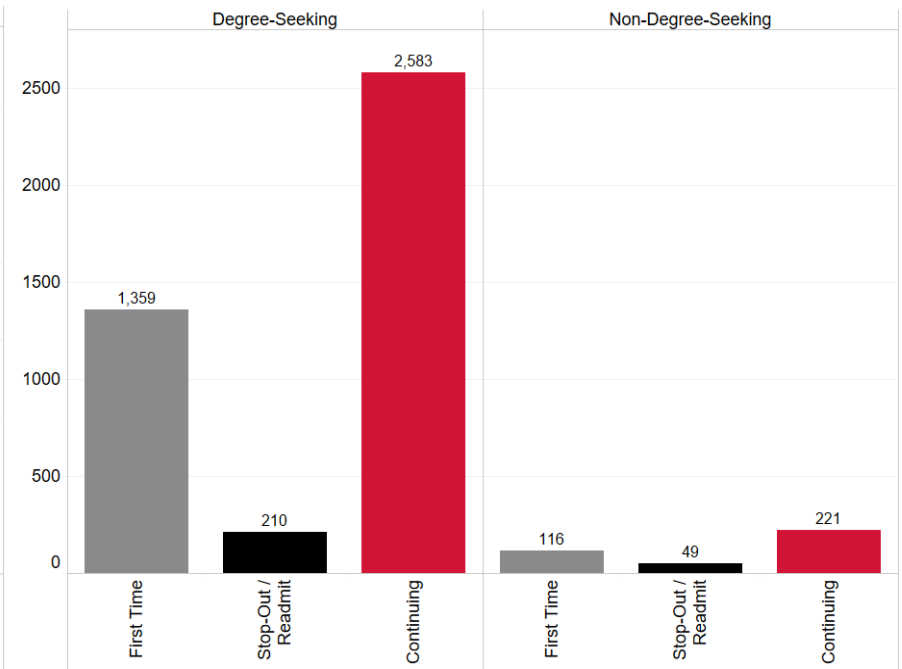

by Registration and Matriculation Status



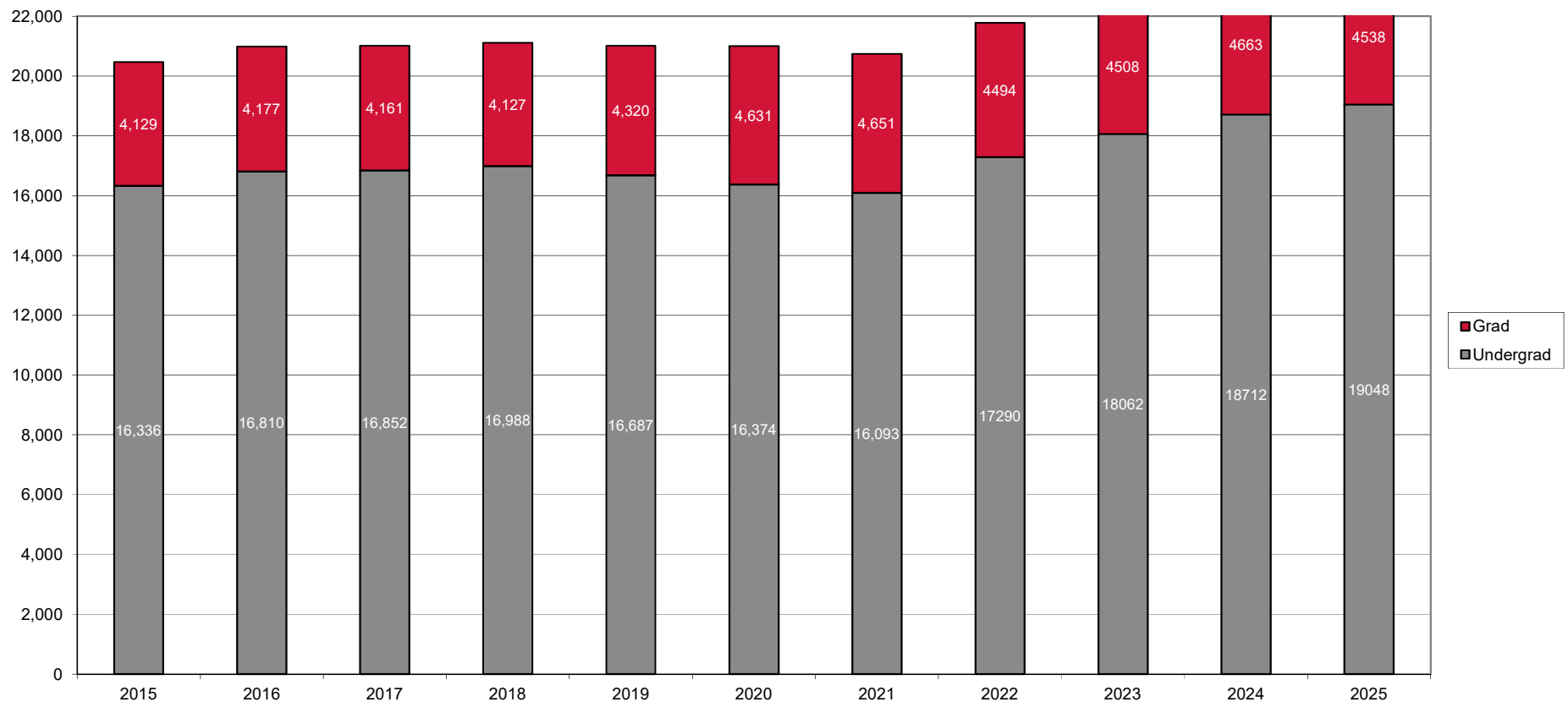

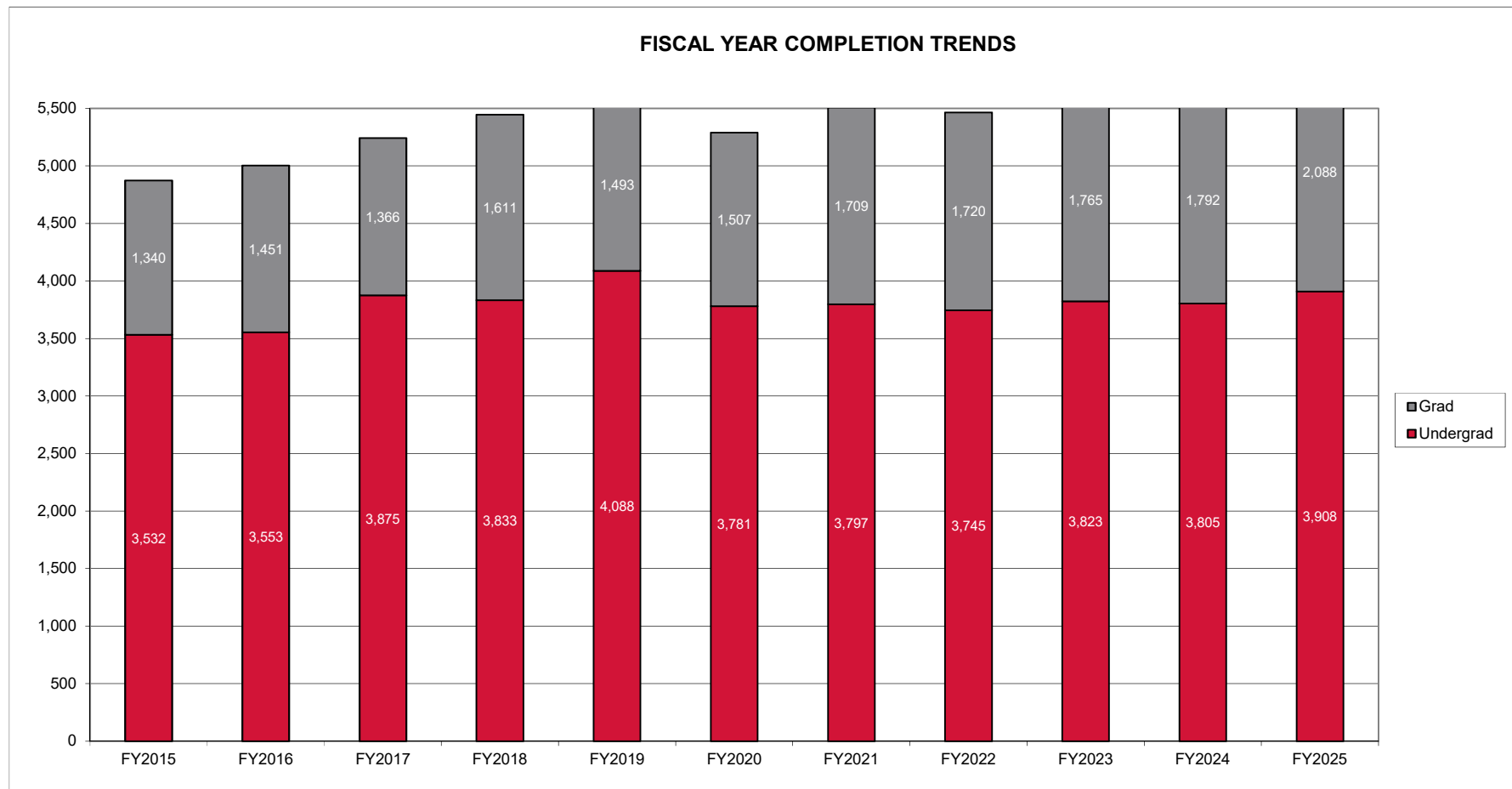

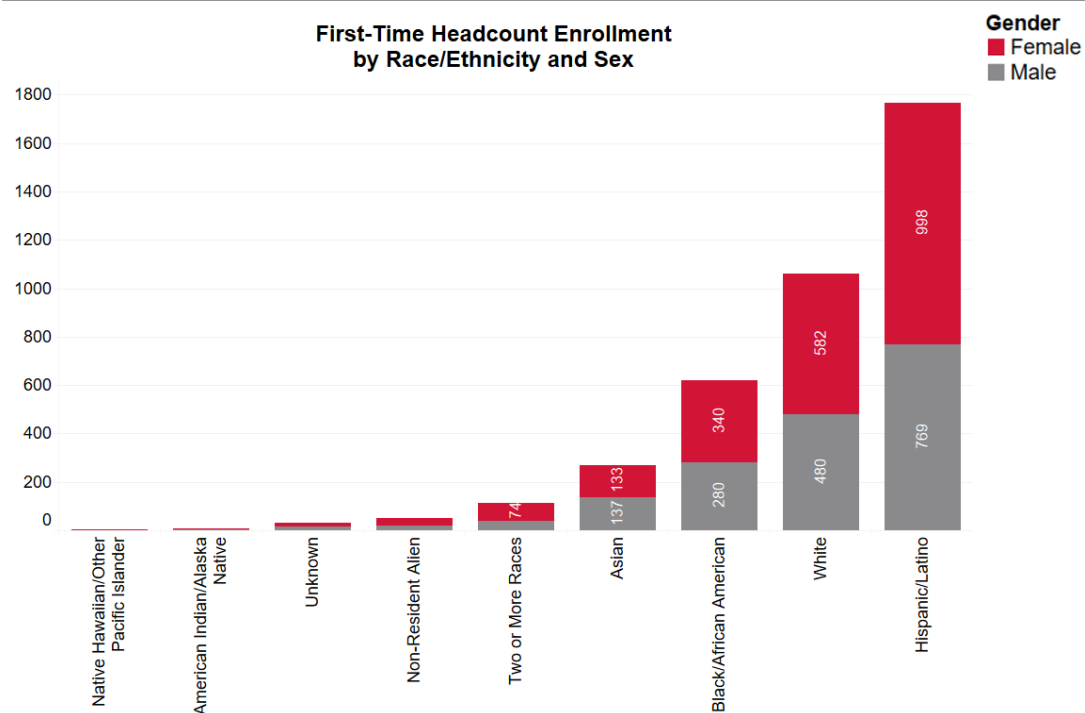

by Race/Ethnicity and Sex**



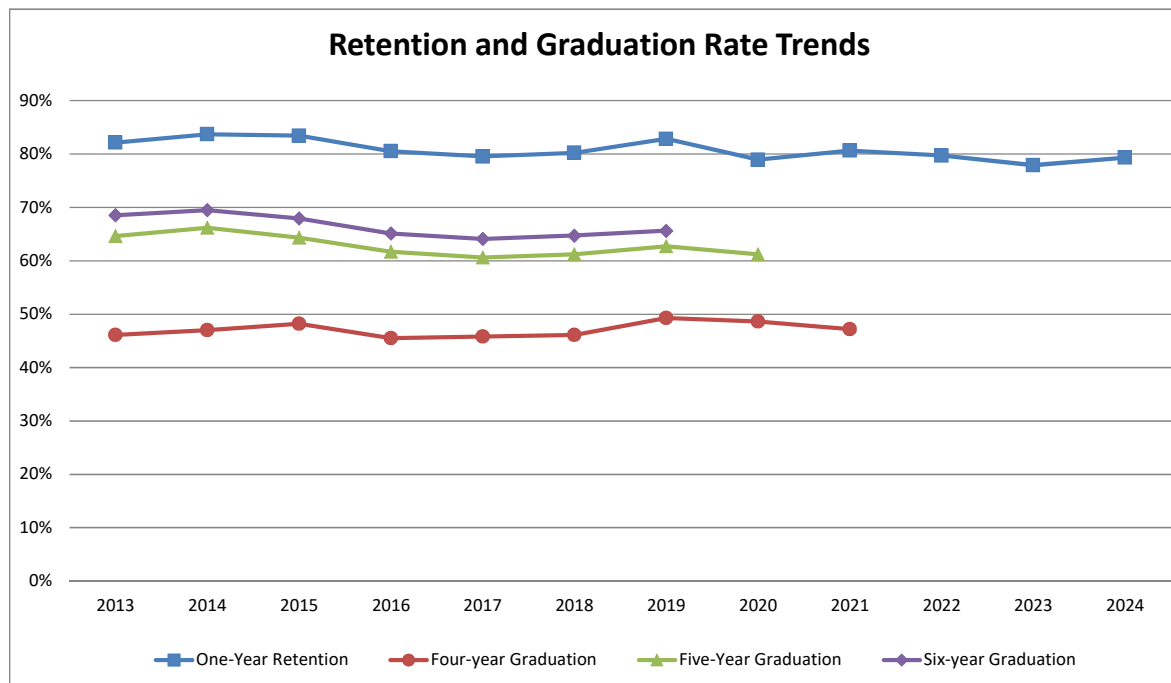

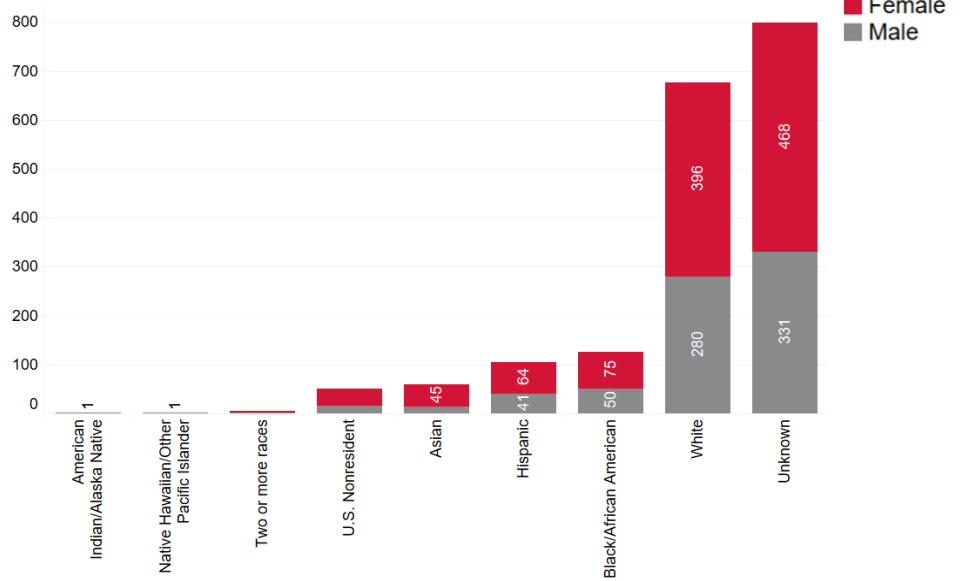

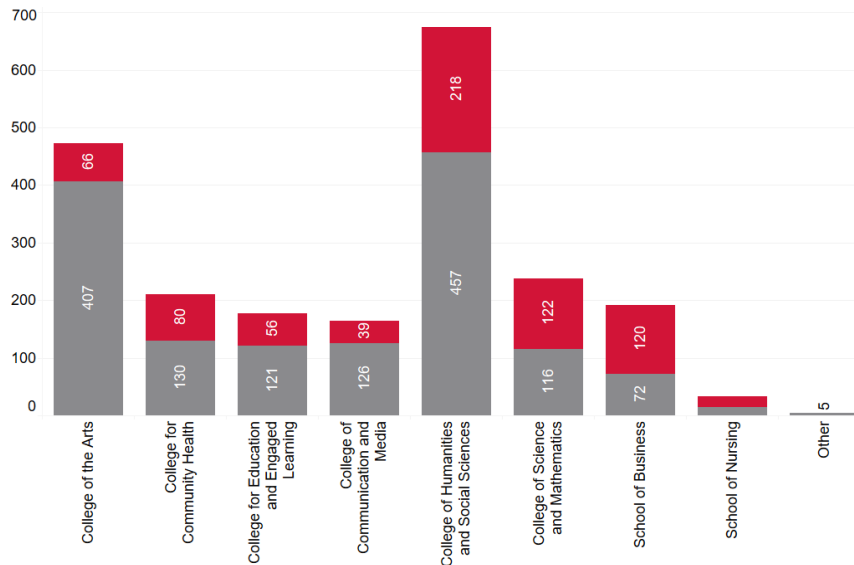
